# **R5 CABOURG [R-H]**

### C1 - PRIX DES GLAIEULS - 2750m (a1 11/16m) - Class D - Harness - EUR € 29.000

**1. HALIZAROSA -** Complicated mare but is undeniably capable of having a say if remaining wise. Unshod behind, has claims

**2. HONEY SWEET GIRL -** An unreliable mare but she is not incapable of getting into the picture in a race of this nature. Dark horse

**3. HIGH TECH ROC** - Has been struggling for form and consistency for some time now so is unlikely to trouble the judge

**4. GALBANE MONTAVAL** - Has nothing noteworthy to her name for a considerable period now so can be ruled out. Others preferred

**5. GYPSIE SLY -** Unreliable but seldom finishes far off the mark on a going day. Hard to trust but is as hard to rule out

**6. HIROISE DU PARJAT -** Has been disappointing recently but has sufficient means. Capable of better now with Yoann Lebourgeois

**7. HELSINKI -** Tends to do well when not disqualified and has caught the eye on occasion. Not without a chance here

**8. HELIGOLAND -** Finished an eye-catching 2nd at this track recently and is well engaged here on the front line. One to beat

**9. HAVANA PARIS -** Consistent for the most part and usually does well when avoiding disqualification. Not to be taken lightly

**10. HAITIAN FIGHT SONG -** Out of sorts lately but has been relatively consistent and usually does well racing unshod behind. Respect

**11. HERAKLION -** Unreliable but usually does well when racing unshod and not disqualified. Should have a role to play here

**12. HUNE LOVE -** Capable but inconsistent mare who has continued to blow hot and cold recently. Races unshod, keep safe

**Summary** : A competitive opening contest in which victory is likely to be fought out between HELIGOLAND (8), who only just failed when 2nd here last time, unshod behind HAITIAN FIGHT SONG (10) and HUNE LOVE (12), who is ideally committed at the ceiling of earnings. HERAKLION (11) and HAVANA PARIS (9) also have the means to join in the fight for the leading positions. HIROISE DU PARJAT (6) completes the shortlist.

### C2 - PRIX DES JONQUILLES - 2750m (a1 11/16m) - National - Class F -Harness - EUR € 23.000

**1. INDIAN LOVE -** Unreliable but seldom finishes far off the mark on a going day. Hard to trust but is as hard to rule out

**2. IPIK DE BELFOND -** Undeniably capable and is well entered on the front row but is often disqualified. Question of his wisdom

**3. ICARE DES HAYES -** Has been struggling for some time now and is unlikely to trouble the judge here. Can be ruled out

**4. INSTINCT DU RENARD -** Has looked rather ordinary for some time now, so his chances are limited even at this level. Ignore

**5. IZIASLAV TEK -** Finished an encouraging 3rd on his reappearance and ought to confirm that form with his shoes removed. Keep safe

**6. IMPULSE TONIC -** Undeniably capable but has been struggling of late. Disqualified in his last three starts, needs to reaffirm

**7. ISALIO JIDO -** Unreliable but was a reassuring 3rd last time and is capable of staking a claim if confirming that form. Has claims

**8. IN LOVE WINNER -** Delicate but has serious means. Sanctioned in both starts this year but the presence of Yoann Lebourgeois in the sulky will earn him supporters

**9. ILUZIO DE BUCY -** Has been struggling to regain any form or consistency for some time now so unlikely to trouble the judge

**10. IRON BIRD DEVOL -** Has done well when avoiding disqualification and has caught the eye in recent outings. Can have a say

**11. INCREDIBLE CHARM -** Unshod on all four feet and is ideally engaged here at the ceiling of earnings. Should not disappoint

**12. IVOIRE DAIRPET -** Consistent sort at the top of his game at present. Runner-up in three of his last four starts and will give this another good go

**13. IN LOVE DE JIEL -** Courageously returned to victory last time and with his hind shoes removed has legitimate claims of following up

**14. IN THE SPOTLIGHT -** Has looked distinctly ordinary for some time now, so his chances are limited even at this level. Ignore

**Summary :** INCREDIBLE CHARM (11) could not dream of a better engagement and ought to take advantage of that by returning to victory. IVOIRE DAIRPET (12) and IN LOVE DE JIEL (13) are in great shape and are likely to pose a threat. IZIASLAV TEK (5), who made a pleasing comeback (3rd), should have more to offer and could have a role to play. IN LOVE WINNER (8) and IRON BIRD DEVOL (10) are complicated but more than capable of staking a claim too.

### C3 - PRIX DES GRASSETTES - 2725m (a1 11/16m) - National - Autostart -Class D - Harness - EUR € 25.000

**1. JOKER DE L'EPINE -** Complicated but capable colt who is ideally positioned on the inside of the front row. Not taken lightly

**2. JYLVIE DE GUEUDE -** An unreliable filly but is not incapable of getting into the picture in a race of this nature. Upset potential

**3. JUPITER -** Acquitted himself well at Enghien last time when unlucky not to have finished even closer. On the shortlist

**4. JAZZY FLIGNY -** Has been in poor recent form in both codes and that does not augur well for his chances here. Overlook

**5. JOYCE DELTO -** Has been gaining momentum this year and boasts solid form references. Should play another leading role

**6. JAFAR CHARENCEY -** Did not go unnoticed in his last start, despite finishing 9th, and will be fully unshod this time for this ideal engagement. Looks formidable

**7. JOCIE DU VILLARD -** Inconsistent filly, has blown hot and cold this year. Sanctioned last time but cannot be written off just yet

**8. JUPPY UP -** Unreliable but seldom finishes far off the mark on a going day. Hard to trust but is as hard to rule out

**9. JONA DE REVE D'OR -** Was a reassuring winner of her last start and is likely to stake a claim here if confirming that improvement

**10. JEWEL CASH -** Last-start winner under the saddle having struggled in harness races previously. Best watched for now

**11. JIFF LINE -** Has looked rather ordinary in three starts this year, so her chances are limited even at this level. Overlook

**12. JAB KISS -** Consistent for the most, maintaining a good level of form for some time now. Unshod behind, should have a role to play

**13. JOKER DU CHOQUEL -** Tends to do well when not disqualified and has caught the eye recently. Can have a say if remaining wise

**14. JADE -** Presented here with the same shoeing configuration as that of his last-start victory at this track. Big player

**Summary**: Ideally committed here to the ceiling of earnings, JAFAR CHARENCEY (6) is taken to make amends after a disappointing last start with all his shoes removed for the occasion. JADE (14) got back to winning ways last time and can fight for victory with a repeat of that performance. JOYCE DELTO (5) has been threatening to win recently and is likely to stake a claim again, having finished 2nd last time. JUPITER (3) and JAB KISS (12) have been performing well in the shoeing configurations retained here, so are also dangerous to dismiss. Last-start winner JONA DE REVE D'OR (9) and JOCIE DU VILLARD (7) complete the shortlist.

### C4 - PRIX DES MATTHIOLES - 2750m (a1 11/16m) - Class E - Mounted -EUR € 22.000

**1. JENNY FRAZEENNE -** Has looked distinctly ordinary to this point, so her chances are limited even at this level. Ignore

**2. JUTURNA -** Her poor recent form in both codes does not augur well for her chances here. Can be ruled out

**3. JACINTHE MIKA -** Sanctioned in her last two starts but usually does well when avoiding disqualification. Not taken lightly

**4. JARKA DE BEYLEV -** Finished a reassuring 3rd in this code last time and is likely to play another leading role if remaining wise

**5. JULIA BONHEUR -** Did not go unnoticed when finishing 5th two starts back but is often disqualified. Best watched for now

**6. JAVA D'ANTAN -** Sanctioned in each of her last four starts but is undeniably capable on a going day. Mathieu Mottier will try to "tame" her

**7. JOIE DES VENTES -** Finished a pleasing 4th under the saddle when switched to this code last time. Could have more to offer

**8. JOLIE DES BAUX -** Has nothing noteworthy to her name to warrant consideration so can be ruled out. Others preferred

**9. JAMBA DE GLADJESS -** Winner under the saddle four starts ago but has struggled in both codes since, so needs to reaffirm. Watch

**10. JOY DE CHOC -** Was a winner in this code five starts back but has failed to confirm since, often disqualified. Must reaffirm

**11. JADE DE BLARY -** Was an impressive winner of her first start under saddle at Saint-Malo last time. Confirmation expected

**12. JASMINE D'AMOUR -** Revealed potential in the harness category and, with Yoann Lebourgeois in the saddle, warrants serious respect on her debut in this code

**Summary :** JADE DE BLARY (11) drew right away from her rivals en route to victory at Saint-Malo in her first start debut under the saddle and seems capable of following up here. She will, however, have to be wary of JASMINE D'AMOUR (12), who had done well in harness races prior to her last start and may have to offer in this category with the help of Yoann Lebourgeois. All of JARKA DE BEYLEV (4), elusive JAVA D'ANTAN (6), and barefoot JACINTHE MIKA (3) could also have a say, provided they remain wise.

### C5 - PRIX DES VALERIANES - 2725m (a1 11/16m) - Autostart - Class D -Harness - EUR € 25.000

**1. KALOA JOSSELYN -** Confirmed her progression by finishing a good 3rd at Enghien last time. Should give this another good go

**2. KIVALA RENARDIER -** Promising filly who boasts the form and experience to play another leading role here. High on the shortlist

**3. KOQUINE D'HERIPRE -** Showed early promise but has failed to confirm it and appears to have gone off the boil. Needs to reaffirm

**4. KALISTA JIEL -** Unreliable filly but has shown sufficient means and is capable of staking a claim in a race like this. Respect

**5. KITTY PIYA -** Inconsistent but does have the means to stake a claim here on the form of her win at Caen two starts back

**6. KULTA -** Tends to do well when not disqualified. Fit and entrusted to Yoann Lebourgeois, she will have supporters

**7. KAVALA DE PADD -** Was far from disgraced at Enghien last time behind some useful opposition. Should have arole to play

**8. KOMSI KOMSA -** Inconsistent filly who isn't incapable of getting a look in here judged on what she has done best. Outsider

**9. KISS THE MOON -** Winner three starts back but has been largely inconsistent to this point. Hard to trust but hard to rule out

**10. KORIGANE D'ERABLE -** Improving last-start winner who won with plenty in hand when opening her account at Amiens last time. Keep safe

**11. KEYPTOWN** - Unreliable filly but has shown sufficient means and is capable of staking a claim in a race like this. Respect

**12. KATE GEDE -** Usually does well when avoiding disqualification and has caught on occasion. Not easily discounted

**13. KATLEEN REYOR -** Showed early promise but has failed to confirm it and appears to have gone off the boil. Needs to reaffirm

**14. KALIFA MESLOISE -** Absent since March but did begin to show improvement, albeit at a lower level, prior to her layoff. Monitor

**Summary :** KALOA JOSSELYN (1) has already revealed serious means and she could have more to offer tried in this shoeing configuration for the first time, so is given the nod ahead of promising KIVALA RENARDIER (2) and consistent KAVALA DE PADD (7). Last-start winner at Amiens KORIGANE D'ERABLE (10) is capable of joining that fight for victory, despite her position on the second row. KITTY PIYA (5) and KULTA (6) are also capable of having a say.

### SELECTIONS

KALOA JOSSELYN (1) - KIVALA RENARDIER (2) - KAVALA DE PADD (7) - KORIGANE D'ERABLE (10)

### C6 - PRIX DES CORYDALES - 2750m (a1 11/16m) - Class F - Mounted -EUR € 19.500

**1. KEMPEL DE GUEZ -** Highly regarded newcomer in whom Jean-Michel Bazire has not hidden his confidence. Follow closely

**2. KOMILFO D'URSIN -** Has looked distinctly ordinary to this point, so his chances are limited even at this level. Overlook

**3. KHEOPS DU PERRON -** Switched to this code with nothing noteworthy to his name in the harness category. Best watched for now

**4. KRUNCH DE L'ITON -** Did not go unnoticed when finishing 6th in his first start under the saddle last time. Will have more to offer

**5. KURT KILY** - Experienced in this category but needs to raise his game to have a say here. Has only a minor role to play

**6. KEEP IT TOGETHER -** Versatile sort, seldom far off the mark in both codes when in the mood. Hard to trust but is hard to rule out

**7. KIKEN GASHI** - Sanctioned last time in a harness race having finished 3rd on debut in this code. Dangerous to dismiss

**8. KIDAM DU METZ -** Runner-up in this code in debut but has failed (disqualified) to confirm in both subsequent starts. Needs to reaffim

**9. KARINO DU DERBY -** Has seldom finished far off the mark on a going day but needs to improve to get a look in. Can be ruled out

**10. KERCHAK -** Finished 2nd under the saddle two starts back and so cannot be discounted back in this code. Dark horse

**11. KID DU RIB -** Didn't go unnoticed when 6th under the saddle two starts back. Should have more to offer, so has claims

**12. KHALIF DEL PHEDO -** has improved with each outing under the saddle, finishing 4th last time. Capable of having a say here

**13. KURLY DE MONGOCHY -** Disappointing although not disgraced when finishing 8th last time. Remains capable of better, keep safe

**14. KIRIKOU DU CLOS -** Would probably have fought for victory at Caen if not for faulting at the top of the straight. Will be a factor

**15. KASH GAGOU -** Complicated but did reveal his potential in the harness category. Not taken lightly switched to this code

**16. KARL LEWIS -** Rediscovered with Yoann Lebourgeois, who led him to victory at Lisieux in a arness race. Debuts under the saddle, winning chance

**Summary**: Wisdom will be key to the outcome. Already a winner in the harness category with Yoann Lebourgeois, KARL LEWIS (16) could make a successful debut under saddle with his partner engaged. However, both improving KIRIKOU DU CLOS (14), runner-up in this code last time, and Jean-Michel Bazire's newcomer KEMPEL DE GUEZ (1) are likely to keep the selection honest. KURLY DE MONGOCHY (13), on the form of his penultimate outing (3rd), is also capable of having a say, while KID DU RIB (11) as well as KRUNCH DE L'ITON (4) could improve on what they've shown in this discipline to get into the picture.

### C7 - PRIX DES IRIS - 2750m (a1 11/16m) - Apprentices-Conditional-Jockeys - Class E - Harness - EUR € 20.000

**1. JAMAIQUE DE MADKER -** Has been struggling for some time now and is unlikely to trouble the judge here. Can be ruled out

**2. JENKA DE MORMOULIN -** Undeniably capable but appears to have gone off the boil recently, so needs to reaffirm. Watch for now

**3. JEYMIXE -** Has struggled to find any form or consistency for some time and is unlikely to trouble the judge. Overlook

**4. JADE THORIS -** Sanctioned shortly after the start last time but has otherwise been consistent for the most part. Cannot be written off just yet

**5. JAMAICA DES ILES -** Arrives in good form and physical condition, so should once again have a role to play in the finish. Respect

**6. JOKE BLUE -** Would have played a leading role in the finish last time had it not been for her fault exiting the last bend. Redemption awaits

**7. JONQUILLE D'AIMTE -** Inconsistent but is not incapable of staking a claim in a race of this nature. Hard to trust but isn't ruled out

**8. JET SET -** Sanctioned last time and in two of her last three outings but did win well at Laval two starts back. Capable of making amends

**9. JUDIRA DE HOUELLE -** Unreliable filly, continues to blow hot and cold but is quite capable of getting into the picture. Outsider

**10. JOSUBIE MESLOISE -** Tends to do well when avoiding disqualification and has caught the eye on occasion. Not taken lightly

**11. JOLIE MAJYC -** Sanctioned in both outings this year but has the means to stake a claim here with all four shoes removed

**12. JUDICIOUS -** Ideally committed to the ceiling of earnings, so has a theoretical chance but must remain wise. Question of wisdom

**Summary** : JOKE BLUE (6) left here with regrets recently (5th) but can find compensation. She will, however, have to be wary of JET SET (8) who has the means to fight for victory and complicated JUDICIOUS (12) who remains capable of making a name for herself in this grade/company. JAMAICA DES ILES (5) represents a training outfit in good form so could also have a say, which could also be said of JADE THORIS (4) and JOLIE MAJYC (11).

### C8 - PRIX DES IBERIS - 2750m (a1 11/16m) - Amateurs - Class G -Harness - EUR € 8.000

**1. HEVA DES NIELLES -** Nothing noteworthy to her name for a considerable period now, and can be ruled out as a result. Overlook

**2. HAPPY BEJI** - Unreliable sort but is quite capable of staking a claim in a race of this nature racing unshod from the front row. Dark horse

**3. GRAXO -** Maintaining a good level of form and consistency, seldom finishing far off the mark. Should be competitive back in the amateur ranks

**4. GABRIEL BRECY -** Has struggled to regain any form or consistency for some time now, so is unlikely to play a role in the finish

**5. GLYCINE VRIE -** Finished a reassuring 3rd last time and should have a role to play if confirming that improvement. Respect

**6. FUEGO DE LIGNY -** Has been struggling for some time now and is unlikely to trouble the judge even with his shoes removed. Overlook

**7. FOSTINE DE CRENNES -** Seldom finishes far off the mark on a going day but has been hard to win with. Others make more appeal

**8. FLICFLAC DU LOGIS -** Arrives in good shape, after a recent 2nd, and has nothing to prove itself at this level. Sets the saturdard

**9. EXOCET DU START -** Last-start winner of a similar contest with this partner and is likely to give this another good go. Candidate for success

**10. EVER FAVORI -** Unreliable but remains capable of making his presence felt at this level. Not disgraced last time and ought to have a say here

**11. GALINE ERCA -** Undeniably capable but has been out of sorts for some time now so needs to reaffirm. Could do better

**Summary :** FLICFLAC DU LOGIS (8) has been nearing a return to winning ways recently and is taken continue his progression by going one better than his recent 2nd. Last-start winner EXOCET DU START (9) and EVER FAVORI (10), who is in search of redemption after recent failures, have the means to pose a threat. GRAXO (3) and GLYCINE VRIE (5) are consistent and also capable of playing a role in the finish. GALINE ERCA (11) appeals most of the remainder.
