- **1. MADAME D'OURVILLE -** A three-year-old filly by Fabulous Wood out of Volkita d'Ourville who is making her debut. Watch the betting
- 2. MARNIE Disqualified in both starts, with the latest being at this track on 18 April. Probably best watched for now
- **3. MISS BLACK BERRY -** Disqualified in her two starts, with the latest being at this course on 18 April. Well bred and is capable of improvement
- **4. MY PRINCESS HAUFOR -** Finished 9th on debut in Class F at Amiens over 2400m on 7 April. Needs major improvement to win
- **5. MANTILLE VRIE -** Much improved last run when fourth in class F over this course and distance on 18 April. Might play a minor role
- **6. MINERVE DE VANDEL -** Not disgraced when 5th in Class F over this course and distance on 12 March. Has a place chance in this line-up

- **4. MILZANO DU BOSSU -** Disqualified on debut at Cholet on 21 April. Capable of improvement but others make more appeal
- **5. MOZART SAUTONNE** Disqualified on debut at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat on 14 April. Capable of much better and could contest the finish
- **6. MOJITO DE BANVILLE -** Showed vast improvement when runner-up in Class G at Ranes over 2150m on 21 April. Has a place chance

- **4. L'HEROINE D'EYMY -** Has only been modest of late and was 8th in Class F at Tours over 2800m on 13 April. Needs to find a few lengths to win
