- **1. INOUIE TIEPY -** Failed to finish the course over 5200m at Strasbourg in a Class 1 cross country event on the 22nd of April 2024. Has solid prior form. Should go close
- 2. BABY BUSINESS Finished a solid 4th over 5200m at Strasbourg in a Class 1 cross country contest on the 22nd of April 2024. Include in all bets
- **3. PARC DE BELLEVILLE -** Ran 3rd over 4700m at Compiegne in a Class 3 cross country event on the 8th of April 2024.Place chance
- **4. GO'N WIN -** Finished 7th over 6000m at Lignieres in a Class 1 cross country contest on the 2nd of March 2024. Others make more appeal
- **5. I RUN -** Won well over 4600m at Cluny in a Class 4 cross country race on the 13th of April 2024. Winning claims

- **2. KISS FROM NIKY -** Won well over 3500m at Montlucon in a Class 5 chasing contest on the 1st of April 2024. Big runner
- **3. INNOVANTE -** Pleasing performance in 3rd spot over 4000m in a Class 3 chasing race at Paray-Le-Monial on the 23rd of March 2024. Include in the play
- **4. WINSTONPRESIDENT -** Finished 7th over hurdles in a Listed limited handicap over 3600m at Auteuil on the 21st of April 2024. Should be a serious threat now chasing
- **5. KALEOTIC -** Finished 5th over 3800m in a Class 3 hurdles event at Lyon Parilly on the 20th of April 2024. Place claims

- **1. SUPER BEND -** Ran a solid race in 3rd position over 3200m at Compiegne in a Class 3 hurdles contest on the 23rd of April 2024. Winning chance
- **2. SAIL ON -** Finished 4th on hurdling debut over 3000m at Auteuil in a maiden event on the 16th of April 2024. Should run a big race
- **3. TWICKENHAM PARK -** Did not finish the race on debut over 3400m at Saint-Cloud on the 20th of April 2024. Others make more appeal
- **4. MARSELAN -** Finished 8th over 2000m at Saint-Cloud in a handicap on the 24th of November 2023. Makes hurdling debut
- **5. LEGACY LINK -** Thrown into the deep end last time out over 3000m in a Listed race at Auteuil on the 27th of April 2024. Would be a surprise winner

- **2. NEOPTOLEME -** Failed to finish the course over 3600m in a Class 2 limited handicap over hurdles at Senonnes-Pouance on the 14th of April 2024. Expect improvement
- **3. TOP DAAY -** Won with quite a bit in hand over 3500m at Moulins in a Claiming race on the 7th of April 2024. Winning claims
- **4. BATTLE CONNEXION -** Finished 2nd over 3400m at Nimes in a claiming race over hurdles on the 28th of April 2024. Upset potential
- **5. NEPTUNE DU LUY -** Runner up over 3400m in a Class 4 hurdles contest at Loudeac on the 31st of March 2024. Each way player

- **3. VIF CREEK -** Ignore last run, was a winner at penultimate over 3800m in Handicap class at Strasbourg. Should be right there. Chance
- **4. INFRA ROUGE -** Ignore last two starts, was a winner over 4700m at Pau before that and can make the presence felt. Strong each way chance
- **5. WILYSON -** Finished 9th over 3800m in a Handicap at Compiegne last time and is hard to fancy. Pass by

VIF CREEK (3) is lightly raced and surely has more to offer. Should be in the shake up.

- **1. LAZYM -** Looks ready for victory, finished 3rd in a Handicap last time over 1200m at Marseille Borely. Strong win
- 2. SPEED LIGHT Attractive debut when 3rd over 1000m at Moulins on the 14th of April and with natural improvement can go close
- **3. WOOTTON MELODY -** More than likely has plenty more to offer. Placed 3rd over 1200m at Deauville on the 10th of last month. Big danger
- **4. AL MINYA -** Finished 6th at Cagnes-Sur-Mer at the second time of asking and needs to do more to feature here. Unlikely winner
- **5. GODAKA -** Good run last time when 2nd over 1000m at Moulins on the 14th of April. Should be very competitive. Strong claims

- **1. SCREEN SHOT -** Ignore last run when 7th at Fontainebleau and judge on penultimate win at Chantilly. An outsider with a place chance
- **2. LET THERE BE ROCK -** Ignore last run, finished 4th over 2100m at Pornichet before that. Should go close and has strong each way claims
- **3. GOLDINO BELLO -** Boasts two good recent wins, won over 1700m at Divonne on the 21st of last month and is confidently selected to win
- **4. FASHIONSPAN -** Finished 9th over 3200m in a Handicap at Cagnes-Sur-Mer in January. Might need this run. Happy to ignore
- **5. BOBBYMURPHY -** Is hard to fancy based on current declining form over various distances. Happy to ignore
- **6. SEE THE LIGHT -** Encouraging 2nd over 2150m at Lyon La Soie on the 6th of April and can make a race of it. Strong each way claims
- **7. AMRITA -** Ignore last two, was a winner over 1900m at Chantilly before that. Include in all bets. Good chance
- **8. MORCOTE -** Will need to progress on recent 5th over 2000m at Fontainebleau on the 30th of last month to feature here. Unlikely
- **9. WARELIA -** Placed 2nd over 2200m in a claiming race last time at Fontainebleau and could go one more. Strong chance

- **2. AL MUZAFFAR -** Needs serious progression on two attempts thus far and would be a surprise winner. Placed 9th last time over 2200m
- **3. PIERREPONT -** Has shown very little in two runs to date and would be a shock winner. Pass by
- **4. LAVENDIN -** Attractive 3rd over 2400m at Salon Provence on the 3rd of April and can threaten here. Strong place chance
- **5. A BEAUREGARD -** Ignore last run when 7th, finished 2nd on debut at Lyon La Soie and can be competitive based on that. Quartet inclusion
- **6. BUBBLE MANSUR -** Will need to build a plenty on debut 8th over 2300m at Le Mans. Happy to wait for improvement

- **3. SAINT LANGIS -** Is in hot form, finished 2nd over 3000m in a Handicap at Fontainebleau on the 13th of April and could be hard to beat. Win
- **4. POET'S BLACK -** Hard to fancy on current form especially most recent 12th at Lyon Parilly over 2400m. Unlikely
