

C1 - PRIX ZETURF - 2550m (a1m1/2) - Class E Race - Harness - EUR € 21,000

1. **LUNE D'OPALE** - Showed some improvement when scoring a claimer at Gournay-en-Bray over 2550m on 27 April. Keeps that shoe arrangement but tackles stronger this time
2. **LAZIE PONT VAUTIER** - Has major disqualification issues and was disqualified last time out at La Capelle on 10 May. Capable of better but is hard to trust
3. **LADY D'ELFE** - Clearly unreliable and was disqualified last time out at Bernay on 12 May. Won her penultimate start and is not out of it
4. **LANA DE BEAUMEE** - Showed some improvement when fourth last time out in Class G at Elbeuf over 2750m on 5 May. More is needed to beat these rivals
5. **LEGYPTIA DE GUEZ** - Showed some improvement when winning her second start which was in Class F at Toulouse over 2325m on 25 February. Capable of earning some money
6. **LIPARI** - Has run well in both her starts so far and was runner-up last time out in Class F at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2550m on 29 April. Can go one better this time
7. **LA NUIT JE MENS** - Fair form and was 5th last time out in Class E at La Capelle over 2700m on 10 May. Can contest the finish
8. **LADY DE GESVRES** - Unreliable and was disqualified last time out at La Capelle on 10 May. Capable of better and has a place chance
9. **LA GUARDIA** - Moderate form this year and was 6th last time out in Class E at this course over 2500m on 25 April. More is needed to win
10. **LA BELLE MIKA** - Improving and was runner-up last time out in Class F at Amiens over 2400m on 19 April. Not out of it
11. **LOLITA D'ECOTAY** - Unreliable but was a winner last time out in Class G at Villedieu-les-Poëles over 2800m on 5 May. Tackles tougher but can make the frame
12. **LILOU D'ATOUT** - A runner-up in both starts to date, with the latest being in Class F at Amiens over 2900m on 4 May. Be right there at the finish once again
13. **LISAS** - Was victorious on her debut and was not disgraced when fourth last time out in Class E at La Capelle over 2700m on 10 May. Should contest the finish again

Summary: LISAS (13) has demonstrated plenty of ability in her two starts to date and looks a solid proposition in her first run over a right-handed course. LIPARI (6) finished second to a well regarded horse on debut at Bordeaux and is one to keep on the shortlist. LILOU D'ATOUT (12) has done nothing wrong in his two starts to date and should go close once again. LA BELLE MIKA (10) is improving and is another candidate for the podium.

Harness - EUR € 21,000**

- 1. LOOK DAIRPET** - Bounced back to best when winning a claimer last time out at Laon over 2650m on 12 May. Tackles stronger but might play a minor role
- 2. L'AMIRAL DU SAPTEL** - Did all that was asked of him when scoring on debut in Class F at Arras over 2900m on 21 April. Could be a threat tackling tougher this time
- 3. LOVE GLYCINES** - Improving and only had one ahead of him last time out in Class F at Challans over 2900m on 28 April. Should fight out the finish
- 4. LOVER ADEMMA** - Won well on debut in Class F at Amiens over 2400m on 13 April. Can follow up in this line-up
- 5. LARRE** - Returned to form when third last time out in Class F at Graignes over 2700m on 3 May. Can contest the finish again
- 6. LORENZO GEDE** - Not disgraced when 5th last time out in Class D at La Capelle over 2750m on 5 May. Could play a minor role
- 7. LORD DE LA FUTAIE** - Improving and scored again when winning in Class F at Saint-Omer over 2625m on 1 May. Deserves some respect for that win
- 8. LORD DU TRIEUX** - Disappointing of late and was 7th last time out in Class E at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 285m on 4 April. Capable of better but others are preferred
- 9. LUCKY DELADOU** - Showed some improvement when third last time out in a claimer at Enghien over 2875m on 18 April. Might play a minor role

Summary: LOVER ADEMMA (4) was a nice winner of his first start at Amiens and ought to confirm with the assistance of Eric Raffin in the kart. LOVE GLYCINES (3) gave a lot to do to the winner when runner-up at Challans last time out and has plenty more to offer. L'AMIRAL DU SAPTEL (2) won on turf first time out and can make an impact on his debut on the sand surface. LARRE (5) is a solid place prospect.

Harness - EUR € 18,000**

1. **KINAYA D'OCCAGNES** - Unreliable and was third last time out in Class F at Amiens over 2400m on 4 May. Can earn some more money
2. **KALINE ELDE** - Yet to win a race and was disqualified in her only start of the year at La Capelle on 10 May. Others are preferred
3. **KALI D'ALONG** - Has improved this year and was fourth last time out in Class H at Châlons-en-Champagne over 2625m on 8 May. Could earn some more money
4. **KARA DE LA BESVRE** - Yet to win and was unplaced last time out in Class F at this course over 2500m on 25 April. Capable of improvement but others are preferred
5. **KELLE** - Unreliable but did run well when runner-up in Class F at La Capelle over 2750m on 28 April. Should contest the finish again
6. **KEIRA SMART** - Yet to win a race but is holding her form well and was third last time out in Class F at Savigny-sur-Braye over 2500m on 9 May. Place chance
7. **KARTE DE HOUELLE** - Yet to win a race but is holding form and was fourth last time out in Class F at Alençon over 2650m on 12 May. Can contest the finish
8. **KANDIA QUICK** - Unreliable and was victorious last time out in Class H at Châlons-en-Champagne over 2600m on 8 May. Can follow up if in the same mood
9. **KEZYA** - Unreliable but did run well when third last time out in Class F at Laval over 2850m on 19 April. Not out of it
10. **KAMILA DES MONTS** - Hard to trust but bounced back to form with a good runner-up performance in Class F at La Capelle over 2750m on 28 April. Has a winning chance
11. **KARLA DES THUYAS** - Unreliable and was 8th last time out in Class F at this course over 2500m on 25 April. More is needed to win this race
12. **KHALIFA CEKE** - Yet to win but was runner-up last time out in Class H at Châlons-en-Champagne over 2600m on 8 May. Place chance
13. **KALIE DU BLEQUIN** - Yet to win a race after 13 attempts but was third last time out in a Mounted race at Elbeuf over 2750m on 8 May. Better under the saddle and others are preferred
14. **KATHLEEN DU NORD** - Disappointing last two runs and was 6th last time out in Class F at Rambouillet over 2800m on 1 May. Needs to find a few lengths to win

Summary: KANDIA QUICK (8) is from a yard who has been having great success at this venue recently and could be the one to side with after a solid success on turf. The switch back to the sand won't be an issue. . KARTE DE HOUELLE (7) is clearly on the up and could be the main danger to the selection. KELLE (5) won well in her first attempt on the sand and ought to confirm. KEZYA (9) is a very capable filly when she keeps her action together.

Harness - EUR € 18,000**

- 1. KENTUCKY DERBY** - Much improved last run when fourth in Class H at Elbeuf over 2750m on 5 May. Can contest the finish again
- 2. KAPTAIN LUCK** - Disappointing this year and was tenth last time out in Class F at this course over 2500m on 25 April. Capable of an upset on best form
- 3. KANAK DE FELLIERE** - Needed his only run of the year when tenth in Class F at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2700m on 29 April. Has won over this distance and is not out of it
- 4. KOPIAD** - Unreliable and was 6th last time out in Class F at Amiens over 2400m on 4 May. Could play a minor role
- 5. KERJACQ DU GAJO** - Yet to win a race and was 7th last time out in Class F at Amiens over 2400m on 4 May. Capable of earning some minor money
- 6. KHEOPS DES VALOIS** - Unreliable and was disqualified last time out at La Capelle over 2700m on 10 May. Capable of better and has a winning chance
- 7. KEOPS DU RIL** - Probably needed his only run of the year when 8th last time out in Class E at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 5 March. Expect improvement and is not out of it
- 8. KENNY NELGER** - Holding form and was fourth last time out in Class F at Méral over 2700m on 12 May. Should contest the finish again
- 9. KUPIDON DU VIVIER** - Moderate of late and was 5th last time out in Class F at La Capelle over 2750m on 10 May. Needs to do more to win this race
- 10. KEROS DE BEAULIEU** - Unreliable and was well beaten last time out in Class E at Feurs over 2050m on 4 September. Could need this returning from a break

Summary: In a very open race, it could pay to side with KENNY NELGER (8) who has been knocking hard at the door with a good last run on turf. But anything could happen and KEOPS DU RIL (7) is sure to improve from a much needed comeback run last time out and is best to keep on the shortlist. KHEOPS DES VALOIS (6) was in contention for success when he lost his stride near the finish line at La Capelle and can be given another chance. KENTUCKY DERBY (1) has had two comeback runs and should be fully fit.

- 1. ICIANO** - Has major disqualification issues and was 9th last time out in Class G at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2700m on 15 April. Needs major improvement to win
- 2. INVINCIBLE MAUZUN** - Returned from a break and was fourth last time out in Class F at Gournay-en-Bray over 2550m on 12 May. Can contest the finish
- 3. INFINIE DU SOLEIL** - Battling to regain winning form but was not disgraced when fourth last time out in Class E at Strasbourg over 2800m on 16 May. Place chance
- 4. IDEAL D'AUCHY** - Showed some improvement when 5th last time out in Class F at Gournay-en-Bray over 2550m on 12 May. Probably needs to do more to win this race
- 5. IPIPOURAX PAULOIS** - Has major disqualification issues and was disqualified last time out at Pontivy on 5 May. Won his penultimate start and cannot be dismissed away entirely

- 10. I LOVE DE VIETTE** - Improved last run when 5th in Class G at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2700m on 15 April. Needs to do more to win this race

- 1. JOHANNA DE BRETT** - Showed some improvement when third last time out in Class F at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2700m on 29 April. Might play a minor role
- 2. JAVA DU MONCEL** - Unreliable but was not disgraced when 5th last time out in Class F at Saint-Omer over 3175m on 1 May. Place chance
- 3. JASPE** - Unreliable but did not run badly when 5th last time out in Class E at Amiens over 2400m on 4 May. Capable of making the frame
- 4. JEZILDA MAUVE** - Returned from a break in good heart and was runner-up last time out in Class F at Nancy over 2600m on 14 April. Will be involved with the finish again
- 5. JAZZMAN SYGA** - Much improved of late and was victorious last time out in Class E at Rambouillet over 2800m on 21 April. Can double up

1. **HENRY DE L'ECLAIR** - Fluffed his lines with a disqualification last time out at Caen on 22 April. In good form before that and is not out of it
2. **HAXOS DE DIGEON** - Battling to regain winning form and was 9th last time out in Class F at La Capelle over 1800m on 10 May. Others are preferred
3. **HAMOUR TEJY** - Holding his form well and was third last time out in Class F at Villedieu-les-Poëles over 2800m on 5 May. Can contest the finish again
4. **HECTOR DU MINON** - Clearly talented but is coming off two disqualifications in a row, with the latest being at Elbeuf on 5 May. Can surprise if wise
5. **HERA D'ESPACE** - Has struggled with disqualifications this year and was disqualified last time out at Jullouville-les-Pins on 9 May. Barefoot this time but others are much preferred
6. **HARLEY DU CHERISAY** - Unreliable and was 6th last time out in Class H at Senonnes-Pouancé over 3000m on 5 May. Capable of improvement and could earn some money
7. **HELIOS D'ANCLEMAX** - Holding form well and was runner-up last time out in Class F at Cholet over 2800m on 14 May. Should fight out the finish again
8. **HIMALAYA TONIQUE** - Moderate form this year and was 7th last time out in Class F at La Capelle over 1800m on 10 May. Needs to find a few lengths to win

- 3. GLOIRE DE LA BASLE** - Battling to regain winning form and was disqualified last time out at Landivisiau on 8 May. Others are much preferred
