- **1. LE SYRAN -** Last ran over 3500m at Dax in September when finishing 2nd in a Class 3 hurdle. Should be fit for return and is not to be overlooked
- 2. LOVELY RISK Good debut run when 2nd at Vichy over 3500m in early May. Looks a nice prospect and should be good enough to win
- **3. CAT D'ASPE -** 2nd at Dax to LADYBOROUGH (4) on May 21st over 3500m on hurdle debut. Not totally out of this
- **4. LADYBOROUGH -** A winner on the last run at Dax in a Class 4 hurdle on May 21st. Can have a say in the finish
- **5. HOLINDA HAS -** Has had two runs, the latter in a Class 2 race when showing promise at Compiegne over 3800m in early April. Player

**Summary**: LOVELY RISK (2) from the powerful Lageneste& Macaire yard looks like the best option in this small field. A nice second on hurdle debut at Vichy in early May, he can progress from that and get his first win. HOLINDA HAS (5) showed a nice bit of promise on her second run in a Class 2 race at Compiegne, and this is much calmer waters. She can make her presence felt. LE SYRAN (1) has been given a break since his last run in September, he was second that day and can get in the mix here. LADYBOROUGH (4) has already got her head in front when successful at Dax on her last run and enters calculations.

- **2. MR LULU -** 3rd on the last run over cross country on April 16th over 4200m at Angouleme. More needed in switch back to hurdles
- **3. JET ITO -** Nice 4th in a handicap over 3900m two runs back. Has dropped in the ratings but is talented and looks the likely winner
- **4. CHERNABOG -** Has been out of form. 4th on the last run over 3900m on April 23rd in a Class 4 hurdle. Hard to fancy
- **5. LA REMONTADA -** Has been 4th on the last two runs, the latter over fences on April 30th over 4000m. In the mix

- 3. FORCE CAT Not out of the frame this year in four runs. A recent 2nd at Agen over 1200m on May 18th. Can not be overlooked
- **4. POLIVATE -** A 10kg drop in the ratings. Has been given a chance to get back on track by the handicapper
