# C1 - PRIX DE LA BARRIERE DE PARIS - 2325m (a1m1/2) - Class B Race - Harness - EUR € 30,000

- **1. MIAMI DREAM -** Has major disqualification issues and faulted last time out at Agen-Le Passage on 23 March. Hard to trust and others make more appeal
- **2. MAURINA BELLA -** Not disgraced when fourth in Class E at Agen-Le Passage over 2575m on 23 March. Has won this course and distance and is capable of an upset
- **3. MY DREAM DES MONTS -** Consistent so far and was not disgraced when fourth in Class C at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2650m on 8 March. Tries further and is not out of it
- **4. MERCEDES DU LOISIR -** Disqualified last time out at Salon-de-Provence on 26 March. Has lost the way of late but did better last year and could play a minor role if wise
- **5. MAJYC FLIGHT -** Holding form and finished third in Class D at Salon-de-Provence over 2200m on 26 March. Can contest the finish again
- **6. MARCOTTE D'ALBRET -** Did not show her best when 7th in Class C at this course over 2750m on 4 April. In good form before that and has a place chance
- **7. MONA LISA ELLIS -** Yet to win a race and was 6th last time out in Class C at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2650m on 8 March. Might play a minor role
- **8. MODESTO -** Has been good so far and was runner-up last time out in Class C at this track over 2950m on 19 February. Be right there at the finish
- **9. MOOREA DE CHANLECY -** Disqualified last time out at Vincennes on 28 March. Unreliable but could be the surprise package of the race if in the right mood
- **10. MAMJACK SACHA** Yet to win but has been runner-up four times already, including last time out in Class C at Vincennes over 2700m on 1 April. Can go one better this time

**Summary:** MAMJACK SACHA (10) has yet to win a race but has gone close on four occasions already. She sets the standard on known form and gets the vote to score. MODESTO (8) has good form and should fight out the finish once again. MAJYC FLIGHT (5) has not been reliable but is capable of contesting the finish. MY DREAM DES MONTS (3) is usually competitive and will not go down without a fight, so can make the frame.

- **1. LIBREVILLE -** Unreliable and was fourth in a Class E Mounted race at this track over 2950m on 14 March. Could be the surprise package of the race this shorter distance
- **2. LUPIN DE BEAUFOUR -** Very unreliable but was runner-up last time out in Class E at thi track over 2750m on 4 April. Could be a threat this shorter distance
- **3. LAZIO BUROIS -** Unbeaten in three starts sine going barefoot, with the latest being in Class F at this track over 2950m on 27 March. Drops in distance but can win again
- **4. LAZIZA DE LIGNY -** A winner of her first three starts but has been disqualified in her last three starts, with the latest being at Châtelaillon-La Rochelle on 9 November. Capable of an upset returning from a break
- **5. LILAS DU MELEUC -** Disappointing form of late and finished 7th in Class E at Marseille-Borély over 3000m on 21 March. Has won over this course and distance and could earn some money
- **6. L'AMI DE LANCOUR -** Disqualified last time out at this track on 19 February. Battling to regain best form and needs to find a few lengths to win
- **7. LIKELY DU PADOUENG -** Only fair of late and finished 5th last time out in Class D at this track over 2750m on 19 February. Better this shorter distance and has a winning chance
- **8. LOOPING GRIFF** Disqualified last time out at this track on 19 February. In good form before that and can be in the mix of things if wise this time
- **9. LILY DES CARREAUX -** Did not show her best when 13th in Class D at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2550m on 27 December. In good form before that but could need this run
- **10. LEOPARD -** Holding form and ran well when third in Class E at this track over 2750m on 4 April. Can contest the finish
- **11. LOUVE D'ENFER -** Showed improved of late and was victorious in Class E over this track and trip on 6 December. Returns from a break but can earn some money
- **12. LISKI DE LA CRIERE -** Has struggled all year and was 11th last time out in Class E at this course over 2750m on 4 April. Needs major improvement to win
- **13. L'AS DUEM -** Unreliable but did finish 6th in Class E at this course over 2750m on 4 April. Might play a minor role at very best

**Summary:** LAZIO BUROIS (3) has won all three of his barefoot races. He drops in distance, but that should not be a problem and he can add to his win tally. LUPIN DE BEAUFOUR (2) is not reliable but could go one better this time after a solid last performance. LEOPARD (10) has held his form of late and can contest the finish. LOOPING GRIFF (8) fluffed his lines with a disqualification last time out but is also not out of it if wise.

- **2. JUST BLACK** Has disqualification issues but was a good third last time out in Class F at this track over 2950m on 14 March. Can contest the finish again
- **3. JALON DU GOUTIER -** Has disqualification issues and was faulted last time out at Carpentras on 30 March. Capable of earning some money when wise
- **4. IGOR DU REGENCY -** Has not won since September 2023 and was 5th last time out in Class F at Villeréal over 2450m on 17 August. Likely to need this run returning from a break
- **5. JOYEUSE DE LAVANCE -** On a long losing run and was 5th last time out in Class E at Agen-Le Passage over 2625m on 23 March. Might play a minor role
- **6. JAHA MAN DU PONT -** On a long losing run and as disqualified last time out at Castillonnès on 30 March. Might play a minor role
- **7. ILIE DE TOUCHYVON -** Disqualified in her last two starts, with the latest being at Agen-Le Passage on 17 November. Returns from a break and is likely to need this run
- **8. IMPACTDARCHE** Has struggled of late and was 9th last time out in Class F at Carpentras over 2650m on 30 March. Needs major improvement to win

- **13. JOHN STEED -** In good shape and was fourth last time out in Class G at this course over 2950m on 27 March. Has won his last two starts when barefoot and is unshod and capable of winning again
- **14. JUST DE LA MORTRIE** Unreliable and was 6th last time out in Class E at Caen over 2200m on 6 March. Could be a threat this shorter distance
- **15. JERRY PONT VAUTIER -** Consistent in 2024 and was runner-up last time out in Class F at Castillonnès over 2450m on 29 September. Could need this run returning from a break
- **16. ICARE DE BANVILLE -** Unreliable but was not disgraced when 5th in Class G at Agen-Le Passage over 2585m on 23 March. Can make the frame

**Summary:** JUST BLACK (2) is not easy to trust but is in very good shape and gets a narrow vote to score in a competitive race. IVAN D'URZY (10) broke a long losing streak when an unshod winner last time out and could double up if in the same mood. JOHN STEED (13) has won his last two starts when barefoot and is unshod again, so is capable of winning once more. JUST DE LA MORTRIE (14) is unreliable but could make the frame.

- **1. KOMSI KOMSA -** Has disqualification issues and faulted last time out at Hyères on 9 February. Hard to trust but is capable of playing a minor role when wise
- **2. KALPINA ORIENTALE -** Disqualified last time out at Auch on 23 February. Fitter this time but has yet to win a race and others are preferred
- **3. KIARA DE LANDEMER -** Improving and was victorious in Class F at Castillonnès over 2450m on 30 March. Can be competitive in this line-up
- **4. KOCCINELLE BEY -** Showed improvement when barefoot and third last time out in Class G at this track over 2325m on 14 March. Remains unshod and can make the frame
- **5. KAVAROLIKA -** Disqualified in her last 5 starts, with the latest being at Beaumont-de-Lomagne on 30 March. Probably best watched for now
- **6. KOQUINE DE RICO -** Unreliable but bounced back to form with a Class F win at Beaumont-de-Lomagne over 2550m on 30 March. Capable of winning but rarely follows up

- **5. KALIN DEROZES -** Disqualified in class F at Toulouse over 2950m on 21 March. Has major disqualification issues and is best watched for now
- **6. KIKIO DU CHATEAU -** Finished 7th in class E at Marseille-Vivaux over 2650m on 28 March. Unreliable and needs to find a few lengths to beat these rivals
