# C1 - PRIX DE L'HIPPODROME D'AGEN - 2750m (a1m1/2) - Class D Race - Harness - EUR € 35,000

- **1. JOJOBA DE QUERAY -** Very consistent this year and was third in Class C at Beaumont-de-Lomagne over 2550m on 24 May. Be right there at the finish once again
- **2. IPSON DU VERNAY -** Showed some improvement when fourth in Class C at Beaumont-de-Lomagne over 2550m on 24 May. Can make the frame
- **3. FIGARO GRAVE -** Has struggled this year and was 8th in Class D at Vichy over 2800m on 2 June. Probably needs to find a few lengths to win
- **4. HAMIRAL NELSON -** Unreliable and finished 13th in Class E at Montauban over 2400m on 8 June. Capable of earning some minor money when in the right mood
- **5. JIM PERRINE -** Bounced back to best with a Class E win at Cholet over 2800m on 28 April. Remains barefoot and can follow up
- **6. FREEDOM (NOR) -** Very consistent this year and was fourth in Class D at Vincennes over 2700m on 23 May. Can make the frame
- **7. MATEO DI QUATTRO -** In very good form this year with three wins, the latest in Class E at Marseille-Borely over 3000m on 4 May. Can score again
- **8. DRAGOWSKI -** Did not show his best when tenth in a Group 3 at Vincennes over 2700m on 14 May. In good form before that and can contest the finish
- **9. JUNKIE (SWE) -** Much improved of late and was runner-up in Class C at Vincennes over 2700m on 22 March. Can go one better this one
- **10. FLASH DE LA NOE -** Has struggled all year and finished 12th in Class D at Agen-Le Passage over 2575m on 31 May. Needs major improvement to win
- **11. JURAE VET -** Disappointing form of late and finished 7th in Class A at Vichy over 3525m on 2 June. Better this distance and is not out of it

**Summary:** Thriving MATEO DI QUATTRO (7) is at the top of his game after 3 consecutive victories so hard to oppose in his bid for a four-timer. Fellow last-start scorer JIM PERRINE (5), an authoritative winner at Cholet in late April, and recent Vincennes runner-up JUNKIE (9), despite her awkward starting position on the second row number, and consistent JOJOBA DE QUERAY (1) all have the means to put an end to the selection's winning sequence. FREEDOM (6) and DRAGOWSKI (8) appeal most of the remainder.

- **2. LEXINGTON D'OYSE -** Has some fair form and finished 5th in Class E at Royan La Palmyre over 2475m on 8 June. Has a place chance in this line-up
- **3. LOLITA DE LORIOL -** Yet to win a race and finished 9th in Class E at Royan La Palmyre over 2475m on 8 June. Capable of better and could play a minor role
- **4. LISKI DE LA CRIERE -** Has struggled all year and finished 11th in Class E at this track over 2150m on 11 April. Needs major improvement to win
- **5. LIEVRE D'ALBRET -** Yet to win a race and finished 7th in Class E at this course over 2325m on 9 May. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- **6. LEOPARD -** Has disqualification issues and faulted last time out at this track on 11 April. Hard to trust but does have a place chance on best form
- **7. L'AS DE CAZOULENE -** Unreliable this year and finished 7th in Class E at Grenade-sur-Garonne over 2725m on 1 June. Capable of an upset on best form
- **8. LEEROY DU PADOUENG -** Has disqualification issues and faulted at this course on 9 May. Capable of contesting the finish when wise
- **9. LOVE DU PASSAGE -** Has struggled in two starts this year, the latest being a disqualification at La Roche-Posay on 1 June. Capable of better but others are preferred
- **10. LOUVE D'ENFER -** Has struggled in all three starts this year, the latest when 7th in Class E at Vichy over 2150m on 11 June. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- **11. LACANAU -** Unreliable this year and was barefoot and 7th in Class F at Villeneuve-sur-Lot over 2625m on 25 May. Capable of better but others make more appeal
- **12. LOUXOR BOCAIN -** A winner of three of just four starts, including last time out in Class F at Beaumont-de-Lomagne over 2400m on 20 April. Can complete a hat-trick
- **13. LUTTEUR DU RIEU -** Disqualified in his last two starts, the latest being at Beaumont-de-Lomagne on 28 April. Did better last year and is capable of a surprise if wise
- **14. LUIGI PAN -** Yet to win a race but is in fair form and was not disgraced when 5th in Class F at Villeneuve-sur-Lot over 2625m on 25 May. Has a place chance in this line-up
- **15. LARNOA** Yet to win a race and was disqualified last time out at Angoulême on 19 May. Needs major improvement to win this race
- **16. LITTLE QUEENIE -** Disqualified last time out at this track on 9 May. Had very good form before that and could be a threat if wise this time

**Summary:** A prolific winner of 3 of his 4 starts, LOUXOR BOCAIN (12) is good value to complete the hattrick, especially given the manner of his consecutive recent victories. Delicate LEEROY DU PADOUENG (8), LITTLE QUEENIE (16), in the same shoeing configuration as she was when a brilliant winner at Agen in early April, and enigmatic LEOPARD (6) seem most likely to trouble the selection. LUIGI PAN (14), associated with Alexandre Abrivard, and LIEVRE D'ALBRET (5) are competitive for the places.

- **3. JEANNETTE PRIORY -** Disqualified last time out at Villeneuve-sur-Lot on 25 May. Has already won 4 times this year and is capable of winning again
- **4. HELIOS D'ELA -** Only modest form this year and finished 5th in Class C at Beaumont-de-Lomagne over 2550m on 24 May. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- **5. FAMEUX SAX -** In good shape and finished fourth in Class A at Hyeres over 2850m on 28 May. Could play a minor role in this line-up
- **6. GENEROUS CHARM** In good shape and finished fourth in Class A at Toulouse over 2950m on 6 June. Has a place chance in this line-up
- **7. GABY DES VALS -** Disappointing last run when 8th in Class A at hyeres over 2850m on 28 May. Needs to find a few lengths to win this race

**Summary:** INDY DE JYR (10) is much better than his recent results indicate but could be worth siding with here judged on his solid right-hand track references. However, he will have to thwart JANGO VICI (12), a convincing last-start winner of a Group III contest at Le Croisé-Laroche. Fellow last-start scorer HARMONISTA (15) and JEANNETTE PRIORY (3), who shouldn't be hastily condmened for a recent disqualification in a high-class field at Vincennes, are also genuine candidates for the podium. JILORD VIVA (1) and HORATIUS D'ELA (11) complete the shortlist.

- **3. INCORRUPTIBLE -** In good shape and finished fourth in Class F over this course and distance on 6 June. Can earn some more money
- **4. ILOHA JIHAIME -** Only modest of late and finished 6th at Issigeac over 3175m on 8 June. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- **5. ILDO DES CHAMPS -** In good form this year and was victorious in Class H at Miramont-de-Guyenne over 2700m on 29 May. Can make the frame

HAWAI DE KERLEAN (9), not hastily condemned for his recent disqualification, and IVOIRE D'AUTHISE (6), after a muchneeded comeback outing, appeal most of the remainder.

- **4. IN LOVE DE VALMIER -** Has improved of late and was fourth in a Class D mounted race at Agen-Le Passage over 2625m on 31 May. More is needed to win
- 5. BEAUTIFUL BOY(ITY) Has disqualification issues and faulted last time out at Agen-Le Passage on 31 May. Others make much more appeal
- **6. CHARLES OP -** Did not show his best when 7th in a Class E harness race at Agen-Le Passage over 2575m on 31 May. Does better in mounted races and can make the frame
- **7. FIRST DES BORDES -** Has disqualification issues and finished 13th in a Class F harness race at Marseille-Borély over 2300m on 18 May. Others make more appeal

HERODO BELLO (10) has won four times in his last six appearances under the saddle and should remain competitive for the leading places. - **3. MARCOTTE D'ALBRET -** Only modest of late and finished 7th in Class C at Royan La Palmyre over 2475m on 4 May. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- **4. MARCHAND DE REVE -** Yet to win but is consistent and finished third in Class D at Agen-Le Passage over 2575m on 31 May. Can play a minor role
- **5. MEXICO -** Was not disgraced when 5th in Class C at Vichy over 2950m on 11 June. Needs to do a bit more to beat these rivals

**Summary:** MISTER DREAM TY (2) didn't go unnoticed last time after his early disqualification so he probably needs only to avoid the same fate to fight for victory. However, MELOMANE DE LOU (8), MANHATTAN EMGE (9) and MY LOVE GIO (7) won't make life easy for the selection and will likely challenge for race honours. MAJYC FLIGHT (10), well entered under these conditions, is also a potential winner.
