- **3. MARCEL SEVEN -** A three-year-old by Exit Money out of Pika Josselyn who is making his debut. Watch the betting.
- **4. MAMBO DE LA VALLEE -** Disqualified at Vincennes on 17 June. Capable of improvement, and could make the frame
- **5. MESSI PIERJI -** Did not show much on his debut when 8th in class G at Erbray 0ver 2675m on 7 June. Capable of improvement and could make the frame

MAESTRO DE BRION (1), qualified in July last year, and MARCEL SEVEN (3), whose dam is a proven producer, lead the opposition ahead of MAMBO DE LA VALLEE (4), who was unlucky on debut under the saddle.
