C1 - PRIX DE SAINT BONNET DE FOUR - 2800m (a2m) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 26,000

1. LEMON DE LA VALLEE - In good form and was runner-up in a class E at Feurs over 2100m on 20 April. Remains barefoot and can fight out the finish

2. LUCKY LUCIANO - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest, in a class E at Vincennes over 2175m on 11 April. Can bounce back to score if wise

3. LUXURY DU DOUAROU - Not reliable runner-up in a class E at Laval over 2850m on 23 April. Remains barefoot and can contest the finish

4. LOUXOR BOCAIN - Finished third in a class E at Beaumont-de-Lomagne over 2550m on 5 April. Can earn some more minor money

5. LE MAGNIFIQUE DJOC - Only modest of late and finished 7th in a class E at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 26 April. Needs to do a bit more to score

6. LOVER DE CHENU - A faller last time out in a class E at Ecommoy over 2750m on 3 May. Remains barefoot and needs to find a few lengths to score

7. LEADER CATZ - Disappointing form of late and was unplaced in a class D at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 31 March. Needs to do more to beat these rivals

8. LEBOSS D'HAVAROCHE - Unreliable and finished 9th in a class E at Rambouillet over 2800m on 3 May. Has a place chance on best form

9. LUPIN DE LA VALLEE - Has some fair form and finished fifth in a class E at Lyon La Soie over 2050m on 29 January. Might play a minor role at best

10. LOVE DE CERIZE - Successful in a class E at Tours over 2800m on 12 April. Remains without shoes and looks capable of following up

11. LUKYA CHOISIE - Finished 6th in a class E at Toulouse over 2750m on 17 April. May need to do a bit more to beat these rivals

Summary: Entrusted to Théo Briand, LUCKY LUCIANO (2) looks capable of bouncing back and set the record straight, provided he stays in stride at the start. The in-form LEMON DE LA VALLEE (1) rates the chief danger, alongside the well-treated LUXURY DU DOUAROU (3) and last-time-out scorer LOVE DE CERIZE (10), who will need to overcome a tricky second-row draw. LEBOSS D'HAVAROCHE (8) is worth another chance after a below-par effort.

**C2 - PRIX DE VENDAT - 2200m (a1m1/2) - Class E - Mounted - EUR €
22,000**

- 1. NEW HOPE DE COUZAN** - A three-year-old gelding by Magnificent Rodney out of Elite de Bas who is making his debut. His Dam won 3 of her 28 starts. Could need this experience
- 2. NEW KADESH** - A three-year-old gelding by Discours Joyeux out of Indiana Gold who is making his debut. His mother never won a race after 3 starts. Others make more appeal
- 3. NINIO DU LOISIR** - A three-year-old colt by Bilibili out of Fanny du Ried who is making his debut. His mother never won a race after 38 starts. Can be a threat on debut
- 4. NEGUS DE FORGES** - Disqualified in a class F mounted race at Lyon-Parilly over 2100m on 22 April. Capable of improvement but others are preferred
- 5. NEMESIS DU LOISIR** - Disqualified in a class F at Lyon-Parilly over 2100m on 22 April. Not easy to trust and others are preferred
- 6. NELSON DE FORGES** - Finished ffth on debut in a class F mounted race at Lyon-Parilly over 2100m on 22 April. May need to do a bit more to beat these rivals
- 7. NIKITA VICI** - Disqualified in a class D at Toulouse over 2325m on 17 April. Needs to find a few lengths to beat these rivals
- 8. NAUSICAA DES MERS** - Showed some improvement when runner-up in a class F at Lyon-Parilly over 2100m on 22 April. Can go one place better
- 9. NAPOLI SAINT JEAN** - In good shape and finished fourth in a class F mounted race at Lyon-Parilly over 2100m on 22 April. Can be competitive once again
- 10. NEPTUNE D'AUVRECY** - Not disgraced when fourth in a class F mounted race at Caen over 2450m on 25 April. Has claims in an open race
- 11. NOOK DE CONROS** - Holding form and finished third in a class F mounted race at Lyon-Parilly over 2100m on 22 April. Should be right there at the finish
- 12. NOSTALGIE CENE** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in a class E harness race at Reims over 2500m on 23 April, Can be a threat trying a mounted race

Summary: Keeping in the correct gait will be crucial here. NEPTUNE D'AUVRECY(10) shaped with promise in a recent outing at Caen and is taken to build on that encouraging effort. NAUSICAA DES MERS (8), who made a pleasing start under the saddle, rates a major threat, while NOSTALGIE CENE (12) is an interesting newcomer to the discipline and warrants respect. The unraced NINIO DU LOISIR (3) catches the eye on debut after qualifying nicely in harness company, having already shown enough in mounted qualification last October to suggest ability.

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C3 - PRIX LE MAYET DE MONTAGNE - 2150m (a1m1/4) - Class B - Harness - EUR € 38,000

- 1. LAGUNE PIYA** - Not reliable and was unplaced in a class B at Vincennes over 2850m on 10 April. Remains barefoot and does not have claims in this line-up
- 2. LAGNU MAG** - Only modest of late and was unplaced in a class B at Vincennes over 2850m on 10 April. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 3. LITTLE STAR FLEURY** - Showed some improvement when fourth in a class B at Enghien over 2875m on 27 April. Remains barefoot and could earn some money
- 4. LERIKA DU CHENE** - In good form and finished fourth in a class B mounted race at Vincennes over 2700m on 31 March. Reverts to barefoot and can score back in a harness race
- 5. L'ATOLL** - Very consistent this year and was a runner-up in a class C at Vincennes over 2700m on 24 April. Remains barefoot and should fight out the finish
- 6. LOVE GLYCINES** - Not reliable but was fifth in a class C at Chateaubriant over 3000m on 22 April. Capable of making the frame
- 7. KALMIO DE LOU** - Not reliable but was a runner-up in a class F at Le Croise-Laroche over 2700m on 27 April. Can go one place better
- 8. LIZZY DE JOUDES** - Victorious in a class C at Cavaillon over 2525m on 7 April. Remains barefoot but is not easy to trust. Has a place chance
- 9. KIANNICK OF NOUIC** - Consistent of late and finished third in a class F at Toulouse over 2750m on 17 April. Might play a minor role
- 10. LORENZO BERRY** - Not reliable and finished 10th in a class D at this track over 2950m on 4 May. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 11. LEA D'ATOUT** - A barefoot winner of a class D at Vincennes over 2100m on 14 April. Remains barefoot and can score again but is very unreliable

Summary: A competitive affair where several hold leading claims. LAGUNE PIYA (1) should be approaching peak fitness now with two runs under her belt. LERIKA DU CHENE (4) is best judged on her penultimate success and would have obvious claims on that form. L'ATOLL (5) has been knocking on the door and deserves to get his head in front sooner rather than later. LOVE GLYCINES (6) also looks ready to strike after a string of encouraging efforts. LITTLE STAR FLEURY (11) has strong place credentials if reproducing her latest performance.

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C4 - PRIX DE MARIGNY - 2800m (a2m) - Class F - Harness - EUR € 32,000

- 1. JET DE BUSSET** - Unreliable and finished 10th in a class D at Laval over 2850m on 23 April. Reverts to barefoot and has a place chance in this line-up
- 2. KENZA KALOUMA** - In good shape and was fourth in a class H at Paray-le-Monial over 2625m on 12 April. Can be competitive once again
- 3. KSAR BLUE BOCAIN** - Unreliable but was runner-up in a class E at Beaumont-de-Lomagne over 2550m on 29 April. Capable of earning some money
- 4. KAISER DE MORTREE** - Disappointing form of late and was unplaced in a class D at Vincennes over 2700m on 28 April. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- 5. JIPSY DES AIRES** - Finished 6th in a class H at Paray-le-Monial over 2625m on 12 April. Capable of a bit better and might play a minor role
- 6. KATSUKI** - Knocking very loudly at the door and was runner-up in a class F at Saint-Brieuc over 2575m on 30 April. Can go one place better
- 7. KELCANTO BELLO** - A winner of a class E at Pontchateau over 2800m on 29 March. Returned from a break that day and is capable of doubling up
- 8. KHEOPS AIREMME** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in a class E at Feurs over 2850m on 20 April. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
- 9. KEVA LUDOISE** - Unreliable but was successful in a class F at Cholet over 2800m on 1 May. Keeps that shoeing and could follow up
- 10. IMPACT OAKS** - Off form and finished 10th in a class F at this track over 2150m on 4 May. Needs major improvement to score
- 11. KAPITANO DE LOU** - Only modest of late and finished 7th in a class E at this track over 2800m on 4 May. Remains barefoot and needs to do a bit more to score
- 12. KEA DES RACQUES** - A barefoot winner of a class E at Reims over 2500m on 23 April. Remains barefoot and could score again but is unreliable
- 13. KEIRA SMART** - Not reliable and finished 6th in a class F at Marseille-Borely over 3000m on 24 April. Others make more appeal

Summary: A striking winner on his seasonal return despite racing shod, KELCANTO BELLO (7) has clearly been kept fresh for this attractive assignment and sets the standard for the field. Four-time course winner KEVA LUDOISE (9) arrives here in excellent heart after confirming her wellbeing at Cholet and, despite a second-row draw, looks the main danger. KATSUKI (6), who is particularly effective on right-handed tracks, also commands respect. KENZA KALOUMA (2) boasts a remarkable record around this venue, never having finished outside the first three in five appearances. JET DE BUSSET (1) goes barefoot for the first time since September and could be primed for a big run as a result.

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**C5 - PRIX DE SAINT MENOUX - 2950m (a2m) - Class B - Harness - EUR €
33,000**

- 1. MAGIC CASH** - Disqualified in a class C at Royan La Palmyre over 2475m on 3 May. Has struggled of late but is capable of an upset on best form
- 2. MY LADY ISLAND** - Did not show her best when 6th in a class D at Vincennes over 2700m on 28 April. Capable of earning some minor money
- 3. MARCHAND DE REVE** - Disqualified three times in a row, the latest in a class D at Enghien over 2150m on 18 April. Remains barefoot but others are preferred
- 4. MUST DREAM** - A winner of a class E at Argentan over 2875m on 13 April. Not reliable but is capable of getting involved with the finish yet again
- 5. MOWGLY FRECA** - Disqualified in a class D at Enghien over 2150m on 18 April. Has probably needed both runs this year and could make the frame this time
- 6. MISTER ROYAL** - In good shape and was a runner-up in a class D at Chateaubriant over 2400m on 22 April. Can be a threat once again
- 7. MY DREAM DU GRAIS** - Not reliable but was fourth in a class D at Enghien over 2150m on 18 April. Might play a minor role at very best
- 8. MAURICIEN** - Successful twice in a row, the latest in a class B at Toulouse over 2950m on 17 April. Capable of a hat-trick
- 9. MESSINA** - Victorious in a class C at Vincennes over 2100m on 20 March. Remains barefoot and is quite capable of following up

Summary: This is an open-looking contest despite the small field. Impressive last-time-out winner MESSINA (9) is taken to defy a handicap over the distance and can follow up if reproducing that latest display. MISTER ROYAL (6) appears to be heading back in the right direction and rates a serious threat. MUST DREAM (4) has the ability to play a leading role provided he remains in the right frame of mind throughout. Interesting also is MOWGLY FRECA (5), who is fitted with this shoeing configuration for the first time and looks capable of making his presence felt in what remains a competitive affair.

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C6 - PRIX DE DOMERAT - 2800m (a2m) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 22,000

1. **MERCEDES DU LOISIR** - Has some fair form and finished fifth in a class E at Lyon-Parilly over 2000m on 26 April. Tries barefoot and could do even better this time
2. **MAKITA BERRY** - Non partante
3. **MISS DE TREMONT** - Very consistent and was runner-up in a class F at La Capelle over 2700m on 3 May. Remains barefoot and can go one place better
4. **MY LADY GREEN** - Finished 6th in a class E at Marseille-Borely over 2300m on 29 April. Remains barefoot and is capable of doing better. Not out of it
5. **MIROITANTE DE PADD** - Has won two of her last three starts, including last time out in a class F at Durtal over 2825m on 1 May. Remains barefoot and can double-up
6. **MA BIMBO** - Has improved of late and was runner-up in a class F at Reims over 2500m on 15 April. Remains barefoot and can get involved with the finish once again
7. **MINNEAPOLIS** - Not reliable and was fifth in a class E at Caen over 2200m on 25 April. Probably needs to find a few lengths to beat these rivals
8. **MUSE DE VANDEL** - Unreliable and finished fifth in a class E at Cavaillon over 2525m on 7 April. Tries barefoot and could be the surprise package of the race
9. **MADRAGUE DAIRPET** - Disqualified in three of last four starts, the latest a class E at Cordemais over 2825m on 15 April. Hard to trust and others make more appeal
10. **MUSE DE TERRAIL** - Not reliable but finished fourth in a class E at Lyon-Parilly over 2000m on 26 April. Remains barefoot and is capable of an upset on best form
11. **MY STAR HIGHLAND** - Finished fourth in a class F at Marseille-Borely over 3000m on 27 March. Has disqualification issues but can earn some money when smart
12. **MAELYS DES BORDES** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in a class E at Lyon-Parilly over 2000m on 26 April. Not easy to trust and others are preferred
13. **MALDIVE DE TILLARD** - Disqualified in a class E mounted race at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 22 April. Unreliable and is better under the saddle
14. **MOON DES GARENNES** - Unreliable and finished 6th in a class E at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 3 May. Needs to do a bit more to score
15. **MUSE DU LOISIR** - Disqualified in a class F at Castillonnes over 2450m on 26 April. Not easy to trust but is capable of a surprise when smart
16. **MILOYA ROSE** - Disqualified in a class E at Lyon La Soie over 2700m on 18 February. Two good wins before that but might need this run after a short break

Summary: MISS DE TREMONT (3) can be forgiven a rare blip at La Capelle, where little went right, and the otherwise ultra-consistent filly is fancied to bounce back to winning ways here. MIROITANTE DE PADD (5) looks the chief threat judged on her excellent record when racing barefoot. MA BIMBO (6) has been knocking on the door and another bold showing looks assured. MY LADY GREEN (4) is worth another chance after a below-par effort that can easily be forgiven.

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C7 - PRIX DE LOUCHY-MONTFAND - 2950m (a2m) - Class D - Harness - EUR € 37,000

1. **ONE LOVE BIANCA** - Showed some improvement when third in a class D over this course and distance on 4 May. Has disqualification issues but is also not out of it
2. **ICE SCOTT** - Only modest of late and finished 7th in a class F at Chatillon-sur-Chalarnonne over 2675m on 1 May. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
3. **FUSION EAGRA** - Unreliable but was a runner-up in a class C at Cholet over 2800m on 27 April. Capable of going one place better
4. **KARVINA D'ELA** - Knocking at the door and was runner-up in a class E at Vincennes over 2100m on 24 April. Remains barefoot and could contest the finish again
5. **IMPACT PLAYER** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in a class E at Reims over 2550m on 23 April. Reverts to barefoot but needs to find a few lengths to score
6. **ICE HAUFOR** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in a class D at Vincennes over 2175m on 30 April. Reverts to barefoot but is hard to trust and others make more appeal
7. **NATURAL MINE** - In good form and finished third in a d class D mounted race at Chateaubriant over 3000m on 22 April. Might play a minor role
8. **JOBALASKO BLEU** - A barefoot winner of a class F mounted race over this course and distance on 4 May. Remains barefoot but may be better under the saddle
9. **KHARNAS** - Not reliable and finished 10th in a class F at Vitre over 3225m on 3 May. Reverts to barefoot and could bounce back to score
10. **HARMONY LA NUIT** - Only modest of late and finished 10th in a class D at this track over 2950m on 4 May. Remains barefoot and could be a threat on best form
11. **IL VIENT DU LUDE** - Victorious in a class D at Vincennes over 2850m on 10 April. Not reliable but does have some claims in a race of this nature
12. **ISTORIC MAUZUN** - Successful a class D over this track and trip on 4 May. Remains barefoot and is capable of following up

Summary: KHARNAS (9) has reportedly been trained with this excellent opportunity in mind and, ideally placed on the front line, looks capable of making a bold bid. ISTORIC MAUZUN (12) arrives on the back of a convincing success on 4 May and rates a major danger. HARMONY LA NUIT (10) is better than her latest display suggests and is entitled to bounce back. FUSION EAGRA (3) has been threatening to regain the winning thread and is another one who enters calculations.

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C8 - PRIX LE MAYET D'ECOLE - 2150m (a1m1/4) - Class C - Harness - EUR € 29,000

- 1. NOVO SUPREME** - Unreliable and finished fifth in a class C at Enghien over 2875m on 18 April. Might play a minor role at very best
- 2. NEMO DES BROUETS** - Did not show his best when 6th in a class C at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 14 April. Capable of better and has a place chance
- 3. NUANCE DE COLMINE** - Successful in a class E at Lyon-Parilly over 2000m on 18 April. Improving and can be competitive in this line-up
- 4. NICE BOY BOURBON** - Disappointing last run when unplaced in a class C at Enghien over 2875m on 18 April. Had some nice wins before that and is not out of it
- 5. NAUSICAA** - Not reliable but was third in a class D at Enghien over 2150m on 27 April. Has disqualification issues but can earn some money when smart
- 6. NORA D'ELCE** - Needed her last run when unplaced in a class B at Vincennes over 2175m on 27 March. Capable of doing better and can bounce back to score
- 7. NISSA LA BELLA** - In good form and was a runner-up in a class D at Enghien over 2150m on 27 April. Keeps that shoeing and could go one better
- 8. NINA HAGEN** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in a class C at Enghien over 2875m on 18 April. Has yet to win a race but can earn some money when smart
- 9. NEW LOOK SENOVILLE** - Returned to form and was a runner-up in a class F at Angers over 2350m on 1 April. Capable of making the frame
- 10. NARKOS DU CHATAULT** - Only modest of late and finished 7th in a class C at Royan La Palmyre over 2475m on 3 May. Needs to do a bit more to score
- 11. NELSON FAFA** - Not reliable and finished fourth in a class E at Meslay-du-Maine over 2875m on 4 May. More is needed to beat these rivals

Summary: A tricky-looking contest where several arrive with realistic claims. NORA D'ELCE (6) is best forgiven her reappearance effort on 27 March, which looked too bad to be true, and she is expected to leave that run well behind with the benefit of race fitness. NISSA LA BELLA (7) remains a filly of considerable promise and still looks capable of better if everything falls into place. NICE BOY BOURBON (4) is worth another chance and would not need to improve much on his better efforts to feature prominently. NUANCE DE COLMINE (3) left a positive impression when scoring at Lyon-Parilly last time and looks capable of following up in this division.
