**C1 - PRIX UNE DE MAI - 2700m (a1 11/16m) - Group 2 - Harness - EUR €
120.000**

1. LINADA BELLA - Form has done nothing but regress since her promising debut and, even with pads fitted, will have too much to do

2. LEVRETTE - Has more than confirmed her promise, latterly open her Vincennes account in style. Modified shoeing on this occasion and must be considered a leading contender

3. LITTLE STRAWBERRY - Can trot but has yet to get off the mark and will need to show considerable improvement on her recent effort

4. LOUISIANE DE BOMO - Won 2 in the provinces before confirming here last month. Finds herself in better company this time but will still acquit herself competitively if she takes to the main track profile

5. LUTECE JISCE - Competent type that made short work of her Vincennes debut. Has freshness on her side and, while unlikely to pull off the hat-trick, can still get in on the action

6. LET ME SHINE GIO - Just one blip on her scorecard to date and most recently put in an exceptional finish behind LIZY JOSSELYN (7). Takes a leap in category though and is unlikely to be considered more than a minor place prospect

7. LIZY JOSSELYN - Capable sort that sprang something of a surprise here 12 days ago but, at this level, is unlikely to make much of an impact

8. LILAS CASTELLE - Justifiably well-regarded sort that most recently trotted 3rd behind LISTENTOTHEMUSIC (11). Pads added this time and looks a decent first-5 chance

9. LUNA NOVA GWEN - Faithful servant that finished 2nd in the race of reference. A repeat appears improbable but will still have her supporters

10. LOPIGNA - Quality element that had to settle for 4th to LISTENTOTHEMUSIC (11) in Gr.3 Prix Vourasie, but with front pads fitted this time, can make amends

11. LISTENTOTHEMUSIC - Has done nothing but progress over recent months and a repeat of her latest performance could well see her double her money

Summary: LEVRETTE (2) may be the least-experienced filly in the field but she is certainly not the least talented. Dynamic here late last month, she is fitted with front pads this time and, with JMB driving, can maintain her unbeaten status. It will be no easy feat though given the progress LOPIGNA (10) has shown since her successful debut, and who will also be fitted with pads for the first time. LISTENTOTHEMUSIC (11) just keeps on improving and the nature of her recent Gr.3 success bodes well for her chances. LOUISIANE DE BOMO (4) has won 3 for 3 but takes to the main track for the first time and looks more a place prospect on this occasion.

C2 - PRIX ALBERT RAYON - 2100m (a1 5/16m) - European - Harness - EUR € 70.000

1. **KILLER QUEEN** - Consistent filly that has gone from strength to strength. Assumes a tougher task this time though and chances limited
2. **KANAKA DE BUSSET** - Filly of considerable ability and has won twice here since the summer. Drops back in category after her recent sanction and can play a role if she stays in stride
3. **KELLE BEAUTE** - Mixes the good with the less good and should be fit after 2 comeback runs. Has an excellent spot behind the car and could well start to set the record straight
4. **RIKITA JP** - Has done nothing but improve since returning to competition. Deserves credit for her recent run here and, from the 4-spot, can make a big splash
5. **ELOIDA** - Tends to deliver at home in Italy but was trounced in the race of reference. Handed a decent draw but still not a priority
6. **KALMIA PERRINE** - Complicated filly but has talent in spades. Benefits from good early speed, breaks on the front line and can make this her own
7. **KAVALA DE PADD** - Fine servant that has been acquitting herself well over recent weeks. Proved herself at this level a fortnight ago and looks competitive for another podium place
8. **KIARA DE VANDEL** - Not the most reliable but has already won here this term. Lost her action behind KALMIA PERRINE (6) last time but should not be too far off the mark if Léo Abrivard keeps her trotting
9. **KESERASERA** - Difficult trotter but has no shortage of ability and encouraged on recent re-entry, despite the sanction. Forced to start wide but can figure prominently if François Lagadeuc successfully navigates the start
10. **ERICA JET** - Moderate Italian trotter that made no impact on her recent return to the capital and again looks to have too much to do
11. **KEEN WINNER** - Back in business after being fitted with pads. On the second row and will have little to offer
12. **EVA KANT GIO** - Good Italian sort making her first appearance for the Guarato stable. Handed a tough draw but Raffin at the helm, and will be no easy touch
13. **EMILY LP** - Deemed good enough to race in Paris off the back of her Italian form, but failed to deliver last month and will have few friends
14. **RAGAZZA DU CHENE** - Useful but has never shown any particular love for Vincennes and, in this category, has limited prospects
15. **KASH LADY** - Seldom fails to deliver when she can keep her action together, proving the point 3 weeks ago, but races shod this time and best to wait

Summary: Following a difficult autumn, KALMIA PERRINE (6) has since got back in the game, latterly trotted 3rd in a Gr.2 and, from the front line, can open her winter account. Two places behind her that day, RIKITA JP (4) finds herself better-positioned on the first row and the mobile start will only work to her advantage. EVA KANT GIO (12) is less-favourably drawn, and debuts in France, but has good speed, is fitted with pads for the occasion, and is entrusted to Eric Raffin for the first time. KAVALA DE PADD (7) won over course and distance before trotting 2nd in a Gr.3 over longer and is certainly in with a shout.

C3 - PRIX DE VINCENNES - 2700m (a1 11/16m) - Group 1 - Mounted - EUR € 240.000

- 1. KOLONEL** - Moderate colt that has not done enough in either code to be considered a player. Disregard
- 2. KAMILLE D'AUTHISE** - Has shown respectable aptitude for the monté discipline but, in this company, looks thoroughly outclassed
- 3. KINGDOM KAT** - No slouch on a good day but never at his ease in Prix Louis Tillaye. Appreciates 2700m here though and, with application, can get a look in
- 4. KALIF LANDIA** - Won with remarkable authority here late last month and, with Benjamin Rochard on board this time, is unlikely to disappoint
- 5. KAISARIA** - Has climbed the class ladder in very good order. A beaten, but surprise, 3rd to KAPULA DE L'EPINE (14) last time out, however chances of repeating seem improbable
- 6. KIRCIE DE GUEZ** - Has taken particularly well to her new vocation. Won 2 of 3 over 2700m here and her Raoul Ballière performance bodes well for her chances of picking up another cheque
- 7. KOBALT DU VALLON** - Well-regarded but has never delivered at anything near this class and others preferred
- 8. KONCORD DELO** - Not an easy horse to handle but has demonstrated decent aptitude for the code. 3rd in Prix Urgent but will have to settle for a lesser spot this time around
- 9. KAYA DREAM** - Complicated trotter but has ability in abundance. Won a Gr.2 during the summer before being sanctioned next time but hind pads fitted on this occasion and Eric Raffin will be more vigilant
- 10. KARLA DE MAI** - Runner-up in her last 2 Gr.2 starts and most recently left a fine impression here, but will struggle to repeat
- 11. KELANIE LORRAINE** - Good, consistent filly that has yet to win a black-type race, but always gives her best and should not be overlooked
- 12. KYRIELLE DES VAUX** - Classy filly that has not put a foot wrong since the autumn break. Thrashed the opposition here recently and, if still on the boil, can win a race of this nature
- 13. KYRIELLE** - Acquitted herself particularly well under the saddle earlier in the year. Has produced some decent harness efforts since but returns to the monté code with hind pads fitted and legitimate ambition
- 14. KAPULA DE L'EPINE** - Like a horse reborn recently, winning 2 successive Gr.2s. Beat KYRIELLE DES VAUX (12) over course and distance in the Gr.2 Prix Louis Tillaye and will not go down without a fight
- 15. KABAKA DE GUEZ** - Excellent servant under harness. Has yet to make her mark in the monté discipline but has shown potential and will generate some interest
- 16. KANDORA BELLA** - Good class of filly with nothing to prove at this level. Oddly lacklustre last time out but is not to be too hastily judged

Summary: Already a Gr.2 winner and placed at the highest level, KYRIELLE DES VAUX (12) produced quite the performance to win the Gr.3 Prix Urgent and, in similar shape, could well confirm. She will still be facing significant opposition from a reinvigorated KAPULA DE L'EPINE (14) who has taken her game to a new level recently, and KYRIELLE (13) who placed under these conditions on her lone appearance under the saddle. KALIF LANDIA (4) made no bones about opening his monté account and has earned the right to take his chances in this class.

**C4 - PRIX DE BRIARE - 2700m (a1 11/16m) - European - Harness - EUR €
59.000**

1. **BIXIO** - Capable Italian trotter but has no place in this field and will have few takers
2. **TITAN YODA** - Well-regarded nordic raider that was very unlucky on his recent Vincennes debut. Is clearly in form and, with Franck Nivard reining, will be afforded every chance
3. **BOCCADAMO** - Gives a good account of himself for the most part but has not been particularly sharp lately and must raise his game
4. **ASTRONASCENTE ZAC** - Can trot and is in shape, but takes on an exalted bunch this time and can expect to find this a stiff test
5. **KING COLE (SWE)** - Has taken particularly well to French conditions and, if focused this time, can put his recent blip behind him
6. **SANTOS DE CASTELLA** - Placed in 2 of 4 since coming south. Steps back up to a trip he appreciates and can improve on his recent performance
7. **M.T.OSCAR** - Useful sort with fine Vincennes credentials but is better a level down and a minor place chance at best
8. **HYMNE DU GERS** - Tough individual that bit off more than he could chew last time out, but is back in his category and can make up for his recent clinker
9. **HEADSCOTT** - Currently enjoying something of a renaissance and has been superb in last two of these races. Shod to preference this time and can impose
10. **HACKER LOVER** - Fine servant that seldom lets the side down when barefoot. Has nothing to prove under these conditions and looks a serious proposition
11. **HAPPY PACHA** - Erratic but has ample ability. Makes first appearance since January and can be ruled out
12. **ZINKO TOP** - Blows hot and cold but always gives what he can. Drops back in category after pleasing over shorter here recently and has a good replacement in François Lagadeuc
13. **FLAUBERT GEDE** - Unremarkable type that has done nothing noteworthy for some time and can be confidently passed over
14. **HAPPYJO DE LIGNY** - Serious trotter that met little opposition in last 2 target races. Prepped for this in the provinces and, unshod all 4, will be no soft touch
15. **GLAMOUR EAGLE** - Hardy element that consistently finishes in the mix. Is clearly in shape and, entrusted to Eric Raffin, will be assured a competitive drive
16. **HUBBLE DU VIVIER** - Competent sort with solid references under these conditions. Caught the eye here a fortnight ago and, with form maintained, can again figure prominently

Summary: Back at his best following a tough start to the season, HEADSCOTT (9) has won two similar events over recent months and, even though seldom seen at Vincennes, he is confirmed over the main track and may just be good enough to hold off HAPPYJO DE LIGNY (14) who is unbeaten in his last 2 barefoot starts. HUBBLE DU VIVIER (16) is rarely far off the mark when unshod and, barefoot this time, will be no pushover. For his part, HACKER LOVER (10) has won 7 of his 9 barefoot runs and thrives over 2700m.

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C5 - PRIX JAG DE BELLOUET-CORNULIER RACES Q1 - 2700m (a1 11/16m) - Internationale - Mounted - EUR € 200.000

- 1. JEROBOAM D'ERABLE** - Capable sort but bites off more than he can chew and can be confidently ruled out
- 2. JALNA ROBSONS** - Has taken better to the monté code than she did to harness racing. Unlikely to pull off the hat-trick but is still in sufficiently good shape to pick up a cheque
- 3. JEWELCANDLE FAC** - Has turned a corner since moving to Bonne's yard and returns to the monté discipline with a respectable chance of finishing in the mix
- 4. JULIANA DE RETZ** - Undeniably capable but has nothing to offer at this level of competition and can be passed over
- 5. JOUMBA DE GUEZ** - Hardy filly that gave a fine account on her recent debut under the saddle. Is barefoot this time around and is not one to be undervalued
- 6. DARDO ZACK** - Springs the occasional surprise but is out of his league here and can expect to have few friends
- 7. JAGUAR DU GOUTIER** - Capable sort that trotted 4th to JE M'ENVOLE (12) in Gr.1 Prix des Elites before losing his action next time, but can make his presence felt if Damien Bonne keeps him trotting
- 8. JADRIUS DE GUEZ** - Has shown a different side to himself since switching codes. Bazire has opted for a new configuration and is sure to garner considerable support
- 9. J'ADORE** - Has not won under the saddle since last February and, even though a generous filly, will struggle to leave her mark
- 10. JELYSO** - Gr.1-winning colt that lost his way after the spring. Makes first appearance for Charley Mottier though and some rehabilitation expected
- 11. JUBILE PRIOR** - Impressive under the saddle here last season. Should be fully fit by now and, barefoot for the occasion, can give this a good go
- 12. JE M'ENVOLE** - Quite simply the attraction of the race. Won a Gr.1 and a brace of Gr.2s in his last 3 starts and, barefoot this time, looks set to continue his victorious ways
- 13. JOYNER SPORT** - Seldom seen under the saddle despite excellent form at Group level. Rather lacklustre last time though and will need to take his game up a notch
- 14. JEAN BALTHAZAR** - Excellent servant in this branch of the game. Has played tit-for-tat with JE M'ENVOLE (12) and will be the one that Mottier fears most
- 15. JUNINHO DRY** - Can trot but has failed to replicate his 3yo form and, 4 pads fitted this time, is unlikely to shake things up

Summary: With a Cornulier ticket up for grabs and the recently exceptional form of JE M'ENVOLE (12), Mathieu Mottier appears to have a lock on this race. That being said, JEAN BALTHAZAR (14) finished closest to him in the Gr.2 Prix Philippe du Rozier after having beaten him in the Gr.2 Prix Camille de Wazières during the autumn, and again looks the main danger. JADRIUS DE GUEZ (8) has taken to the monté code like a duck to water, sports modified shoeing, and a repeat of his Gr.2 Prix Ceneri Forcinal performance would see him finish close once more. Third in the race of reference on her monté debut, JOUMBA DE GUEZ (5) is barefoot for the first time this term and must be respected.

**C6 - PRIX JEAN DUMOUCHE - 2850m (a1 3/4m) - European - Harness - EUR
€ 90.000**

- 1. HE AND ME** - Faithful servant that has turned a corner over recent weeks. Superb here last time out and looks the main threat to the favourite's supremacy
- 2. HIP HOP HAUFOR** - Has raced, placed and won at a superior level. Returns to his code of preference after a prep under the saddle and, if focused, can play a prominent role
- 3. FARAH DES CAUX** - Previously a good sort but lost her way late last season and picked up this year where she left off. Disregard
- 4. FAKIR DE MAHEY** - Hardy servant that is back on track after a quartet of sanctions. Comes here fresh, has references over 2850m on the main track and, in current form, is hard to ignore
- 5. GOELAND D'HAUFOR** - Reliability not his strong suit but has nothing to prove in this class. Sanctioned when full of running last time out and will not be far off the mark if Damien Bonne can keep him trotting
- 6. ADMIRAL AS (ITY)** - Quality nordic raider with excellent references from 2640m-3140m. Comes here fresh and can make a big splash if he takes to Vincennes conditions
- 7. DOUX PARFUM** - Pleased more than once here last winter but is a far cry from that form and can expect to have few takers
- 8. HELIADE DU GOUTIER** - No slouch on a good day but struggled in her last 2 at this level and needs to raise her game
- 9. ELITE DE JIEL** - Excellent here last winter but has so far failed to replicate that form and others preferred
- 10. GAMAY DE L'ITON** - Tough campaigner that thrives over 2850m here. Beaten only by a very good horse last month and, after a freshener over shorter, is barefoot for the occasion and can dictate the law

Summary: Twice a winner over course and distance during the spring, GAMAY DE L'ITON (10) kept up his productive ways during the autumn and, prepped for this 10 days ago here, he is back to racing barefoot and will take all the beating. Principal opposition will take the form of HE AND ME (1) who won over 2700m with consummate authority last time out, and a barefoot HIP HOP HAUFOR (2) who should be able to find his feet again at this level. Well-regarded Swedish campaigner, ADMIRAL AS (ITY) (6) takes his first competitive steps south of Scandinavia and, effective over these longer trips, must be taken seriously.

C7 - PRIX BILIBILI-CORNULIER RACES Q2 - 2700m (a1 11/16m) - Internationale - Mounted - EUR € 200.000

1. **IRINA DU RIS** - Delicate but seldom disappoints when applied. Takes on a big task this time around and chances appear limited
2. **IRINA DE BAILLY** - Capable on a good day and has been acquitting herself respectably, but looks to have too much to do this time around
3. **IN LOVE DU CHOQUEL** - Consistently in the thick of things when he can stay in stride. 3rd to IDEALE DU CHENE (11) in the race of reference and, barefoot on this occasion, is worth keeping an eye on
4. **IVANKA DE JILME** - Held her own on monté debut last month but has a lot more to find in order to compete at this level
5. **INOUI DANICA** - Honest trotter that finished 4th in the race of reference. Is unlikely to repeat but will certainly not be sent out at 90/1 on this occasion
6. **INSHORE** - Never far from losing his action but has talent to burn. Won a pair of Gr.2 events last season and, if at peak fitness, can get straight back in the game
7. **IMPRESSIONIST** - Useful under harness but disappointing g of late. Debuts in the monté code with Benjamin Rochard in the irons, has hind shoes off, but others still easier to back
8. **IT'S A DOLLARMAKER** - Sanctioned on his sole start under the saddle. Has since been superb in the other code and, if form transitions, his place is on the podium
9. **INES DES RIOULTS** - Has not got her nose in front for 18 months but is an honest trotter. Gets on well with Florian Desmigneux and must be retained
10. **INA DU RIB** - By some margin, the classiest horse in the field. Goes barefoot in a bid to exact revenge on IDEALE DU CHENE (11) and looks thoroughly capable of pulling it off
11. **IDEALE DU CHENE** - Serious mare that returned to winning ways last time out. Is not incapable of repeating her recent performance but a barefoot INA DU RIB (10) may relegate her to playing second fiddle

Summary: A veritable metronome in the monté code, INA DU RIB (10) goes barefoot for the first time since winning the Gr.1 Prix de Normandie last June and can turn the tables on the good IDEALE DU CHENE (11) who beat him in the Gr.2 Prix Joseph Lafosse late last month. Course-and-distance specialist, IT'S A DOLLARMAKER (8) was not over-taxed in a Gr.3 under harness on the same day and makes his second competitive appearance under the saddle with justified ambition. INSHORE (6) may regularly prove tricky but his ability is not in question and, competitively shod, will be dangerous if Alexandre Abrivard can keep him trotting.

C8 - PRIX GENERAL DU POMMEAU - 2850m (a1 3/4m) - European - Harness - EUR € 60.000

1. **GLOBAL CHIT CHAT** - Well-regarded in her native Sweden but is shod for first French start and will need the run
2. **ISOFOU DU CHENE** - Excellent campaigner at a lower level but the step up in class looks a step too far
3. **CROIZEROSS** - Capable at home in his native Italy but was trounced in both appearances since crossing the Alps and will have few takers
4. **CONDOR BAR** - Pleased on 2 occasions here earlier in his career but is a shadow of his former self and can be ruled out
5. **JIMMY FERRO BR** - Serious trotter with nothing to prove in this class of race. Prepared for this and barefoot for the occasion, he is reunited with Matthieu Abrivard and can impose
6. **GLOBAL YANKEE** - Useful Danish trotter but failed to make any impression on French debut across town. Has had time to get in shape but others preferred on this occasion
7. **IBERICA** - Very hard to fault in current configuration and, if focused, can get a look in
8. **IRON JET** - Blows hot and cold but has been in fine form since the summer. Impressed here on re-entry, will have come on for the run, and must be worth retaining
9. **ILAYA** - Fine servant that was oddly below-par here last month. Goes barefoot again and the Yoann Lebourgeois-factor cannot be ignored
10. **IMOKO JIBELAU** - Fine servant that bit off more than he could chew here a fortnight ago. Drops back in category and should make amends, but is by no means a priority
11. **COOL KRONOS** - Simply superb in both codes over recent months. Specifically prepared for this and, unshod all 4, can have his day in the sun
12. **BEAT GENERATION** - Useful dual-discipline trotter returning to the harness code after a re-entry under the saddle. Nivard at the helm but still not an obvious choice
13. **IMPERIAL MABON** - Quality element but is still being conditioned and best to hold off
14. **INDY DE JYR** - Occasionally loses focus but is otherwise a tough trotter with references in this category and, in current condition, is very easy to like
15. **IDYLLE EXPRESS** - Has not won since the spring but has been in excellent shape for some time and, even against the boys this time, she still looks competitively well in
16. **DONIZETTI (SWE)** - Quality Swedish trotter with form at a superior level. Comes here fresh and if race-fit, will have his chances

Summary: Successful over course and distance here last winter, JIMMY FERRO BR (5) has continued his productive ways since and returns barefoot to Vincennes with a realistic chance of getting straight down to business. Matthieu Abrivard will still be keeping a keen eye on the fine COOL KRONOS (11) who races barefoot for his first December objective, and INDY DE JYR (14) who has been in cracking form since winning a similar event at Enghien during the summer. Unraced since early-October, DONIZETTI (SWE) (16) is nevertheless shod for competition and is not to be underestimated.

**C9 - PRIX JULES LEPENNETIER - 2850m (a1 3/4m) - Class - Harness -
EUR € 52.000**

- 1. JABALPUR** - Solid at this level during the spring and has picked up where he left off. Unlikely to have his way but can still compete for some prizemoney
- 2. JALIMEDE** - Moderate trotter that always gives his best but has not done enough lately to be considered a player
- 3. JAZZ DE PERVENCHE** - Useful in both codes but has not been firing on all cylinders this term and must get his house in order
- 4. JONGLEUSE DE LUNE** - Well-regarded at home and won here earlier in the month. Showed her form before being sanctioned next time and should not be written off
- 5. JASON** - Quality element that has won 4 of his last 6. Is confirmed over 2850m here and looks the main threat to JINGLE DU PONT (9)
- 6. JENNY DE JOUDES** - Showed significant ability last season. Found wanting on comeback but has had time to get in shape and will have her supporters
- 7. JEWEL DE BANVILLE** - Talented type preparing for a campaign under the saddle and can be passed over
- 8. JIOSCO DE PHYT'S** - Can trot but reliability not his strong suit. Shoes on this time and no threat
- 9. JINGLE DU PONT** - Fine campaigner that has hardly put a foot wrong of late. Impressive last time out and can complement his recent course-and-distance victory
- 10. JANGO VICI** - Form goes through phases and is currently in good shape. Pleased in marginally better company last time and, with form maintained, can again make the frame
- 11. JINGLE DELO** - Not the easiest of horses to handle but recently showed his form at Laval and, unshod all 4 this time, will be in with a shout if David Thomain keeps him trotting
- 12. JEEGHA PRIDE** - Won over track and trip during the spring but has been less performant since. Sports a new configuration this time though and can start to redeem herself

Summary: Remarkably effective when shod as he is at present, JINGLE DU PONT (9) recently opened his Gr.3 account with a tenacious run over course and distance and looks eminently capable of repeating. He will however face opposition from JASON (5) who has been a revelation since the spring, and JANGO VICI (10) who is back on track following a lean autumn. JINGLE DELO (11) is a complicated individual but has references in superior company and, barefoot this time, will be dangerous if he keeps his action together.
