- **4. ICEMAN BLEU -** Has disqualification issues but if stays on the trot has claims at the win. Go close if smart
- **5. ILIEN DE VRIE -** Reverts to barefoot and failed narrowly to Iceman Bleu in the latest start. Has sufficient means to fight for victory
