**1. KASH MADRIK -** Sanctioned in a Vincennes Class D over 2175m on 18 January comeback. Probably still race-rusty and others preferred

**2. ELITE D'ARC** - Tricky type but can trot when focused. Latterly won over the distance in Milan but faces a stiffer test this time around

**3. KINGSTON DE BLARY -** Unraced since faulting in a Class C over track and trip on New Year's Day. Has merit but must nevertheless get his house in order

**4. EK DEL RONCO** - 4th of 15 in a 2850m Class D here last Tuesday. Will not be inconvenienced by the change of trip and, barefoot again, can make the frame

**5. KATAKI DE WALLIS** - Complicated colt that has continued his difficult streak since moving yard. Sanctioned in a Class B over 2700m here a fortnight ago and can be ruled out

**6. KEOPS TILLAYE** - Continued his poor streak with an 8th place finish in a Class C over track and trip early last month and will struggle to make any impact

7. KEPI DEL - Quality colt that lost his action in a monté Gr.2 over 2175m here two months ago. Has bags of ability but stays shod and best to hold off

**8. KWARTZ SIBEY -** Has done nothing but improve in Paris this winter and ended 2023 on a high note over course and distance. Comes here fresh but stays shod for the occasion and not a serious proposition this time

**9. EHLERT PAR -** Faulted on re-entry in the Gr.3 Prix Bellino II over course and distance 3 weeks ago on his maiden start for the Souloy stable. Will have come on for the run and, at this level, can make the first 5

**10. KEN DU POMMEREUX** - Unseen since finishing unplaced in a Class A over track and trip last September and is not about to wow the crowds

**11. KARMA** - Remarkably consistent colt that has taken well to these conditions, latterly 3rd in a Class C on 19 December. Steps up in category but still warrants respect

**12. ENOCK** - Has made his mark in Italy but has no references beyond 2100m. Entrusted to Matthieu Abrivard for his French debut though and can be assured a competitive drive

**13. KALINOU QUICK** - Honest type that trotted 5th of 15 in a Class B over 2175m 3 weeks ago. Will appreciate a return to 2700m and the Raffin-factor cannot be ignored. Claim

**14. ERNESTO ROC** - Sanctioned in a Gr.3 under these conditions on 28 December but was very unlucky that day and, with more focus, can make amends and win this

**15. KATIM DU GOUTIER** - Not the most fortunate when 6th in a Class B over 2175 here on 12 January after having run 2nd over 2700m the previous month, but is a tough individual and can set the record straight

**Summary:** It looks like an Italy v France match here with transalpine import ERNESTO ROC (14) making a first barefoot start for his new handler and, with application, may just have the measure of the progressive KALINOU QUICK (13) who benefits from an Eric RAFFIN drive for the first time. KATIM DU GOUTIER (15) came close under these conditions in early-December and, barefoot this time, will be no pushover. Excellent at home in Italy, EK DEL RONCO (4) left a good impression on his Vincennes debut and Yoann Lebourgeois has maintained faith.

**2. DARDO ZACK -** 5th in 2700m harness Gr.3 here a fortnight ago. Has shown considerable potential in this branch of the game and will generate interest

**3. BEAT GENERATION -** Never dangerous 9th of 13 finishers in a 2850m Class A under harness here early last month but returns to a discipline in which he boasts a 75% win-rate and must be respected

**4. IDAHO A LA BRUYERE -** Below-par 7th in a Cordemais Class E over 2825m on 17 January. New shoeing formula but, in current condition, looks a rank outsider

**5. IBERIK DE MONGOCHY -** Sanctioned in a Class C over course and distance 2 weeks ago and, while not without merit, current form does little to inspire confidence

**6. IRINA DE BAILLY -** Well-beaten 6th of 9 in Gr.3 Prix Léon Tacquet over 2700m here in early-January. Pleased last time over the distance though and should not be entirely written-off

**7. J'ADORE -** Sprang something of a surprise when 5th of 7 finishers in Gr.2 Prix Camille Blast over track and trip last weekend. Shoes back on though and others preferred

**8. DON'T SAY GAR -** Debuts under the saddle after trotting 3rd in a 2700m harness Gr.2 here a fortnight back and will be no soft touch if form transitions. Place prospect

**9. JAZZ IN MONTREUX -** Outclassed the opposition in Gr.3 Prix Léon Tacquet over 2700m here on 6 January and is eminently capable of doubling his money

**Summary:** Simply superb since last summer, winning five straight under the saddle, JAZZ IN MONTREUX (9) boasts a good record over 2175m here and will be expected to complement his recent Gr.3 victory. Third to him that day, after having won over the short course, JUPITER DE PLAY (1) will lead the opposition together with monté debutante DON'T SAY GAR (8) who thrives at the venue, sports a new configuration, and who will be partnered by Eric RAFFIN for the occasion. BEAT GENERATION (3) has fine monté references and should appreciate the return to a shorter trip.

**3. LOULOU DE MYE -** Still had gas in the tank when sanctioned in recent Prix Paul Viel. Shoes back on but may find the mobile start to his liking

**4. LEARN TO FLY -** Surprising 4th of 7 finishers in the in Gr.2 Prix Paul Viel over 2700m last weekend and will not be available at 97/1 this time around

**5. LOGAN JIEL -** Remarkably consistent colt that courageously won a 2175m Class A here 2 weeks ago and the hat-trick looks a distinct possibility

**6. LARGO DE CASTELLE -** Quickly sanctioned in Gr.2 Prix Maurice de Gheest over 2175m here early last month. First time in a mobile start but others still easier to back

**7. LA JOIE DE VIVRE -** Sanctioned en route to picking up a place in a 2700m Class B here 3 weeks ago. Hind pads fitted this time and will have her supporters

**8. LAPIS LAZULI -** Progressive sort that lost his action in 2700m Gr.2 Prix Paul Viel last weekend. Will not be bothered by the wide draw and, if focused, will be the one to beat

**Summary:** While still somewhat green, LAPIS LAZULI (8) nevertheless has talent in spades and, even though racing shod, can win a race of this nature if JMB keeps him trotting. That said, he will be pitted against the improving LOGAN JIEL (5) who is better-positioned behind the car. LASH PERRINE (2) got back in the game at a higher level here a month back and looks capable of making the frame once more.

**3. FISTON A PAPA -** Came in 11th of 14 finishers after having faulted in a 3000m Nantes Class E last weekend and, on this occasion, can expect to find the going tougher

**4. EDI JOSSELYN** - Good second in a 2925m Cagnes Class D this time last month. Trotted 3rd to EASY BLEU (5) here 6 days earlier and is unlikely to be far from the action

**5. EASY BLEU** - Given an easy race in a 2625m Agen Class B a fortnight ago when being given a conditioner. Beat FAKIR DE L'AULNE (7) the time before though and has a decent chance of confirming

6. FULMIDA - Looked very ordinary when 10th of 13 under similar conditions on 22 January and will have nothing to offer

**7. FAKIR DE L'AULNE -** Has taken his game to a new level this winter, latterly flying up in a 3000m Nantes Class E. Confirmed over track and trip in late-December and, barefoot this time, can wrap this up

**8. FOLLOW ME FLASH** - Unthreatening 9th of 12 in a Vincennes Class C over 2850m on New Year's Day. In the frame in previous 2 though and the change of configuration should work in his favour

**9. FEELING BOY -** Lacklustre 4th in a 2850m Vincennes monté Class D in late-December. Barefoot under harness this time however and can pick up a cheque if form transitions

**10. FERLAINE** - Won an amateur 4125m Class E here a fortnight back only to lose it after an inquiry. If behaved and in similar form, she could well get a look-in

11. FELLI ELEVEN - Has ample ability but has not been seen out for 11 months and will need the run

**12. FILOU SMILING** - Respectable 3rd in an amateur 4125m Class E here 2 weeks ago. Returns to racing barefoot and will garner support

**13. FURIEUSE PURPLE -** 10th in a 2100m Vincennes Class D on 6 January when still being conditioned. Tends to go better over shorter but is in her category and is unlikely to disappoint

**14. DANDY GEDE -** Modest individual making first appearance since finishing unplaced in a 2150m Enghien claimer last August and can be confidently passed over

**15. DESTIN DE STAR -** Faithful servant that trotted 3rd in a Lyon-Parilly Class D over 2600m mid-December. Unraced since but should nevertheless generate some interest

**16. ECUME DE FURETAIS** - Erratic mare that failed to fire in a 2100m Class D here a fortnight back after having placed over track and trip. Is not easy to trust but is still worth keeping an eye on

**Summary:** An easy winner at Nantes just over a fortnight ago after having finished 3rd on his Vincennes debut under similar conditions, FAKIR DE L'AULNE (7) has the wherewithal to win in this category. EASY BLEU (5) finished ahead of him here that day and, barefoot this time, can put on another good show, but he may first have to defer to the fine FURIEUSE PURPLE (13) who will be fully fit following a brace of conditioners. EDI JOSSELYN (4) has been knocking at the door for some time and is not incapable of trotting his way onto the podium.

**2. IZAAC D'HAVAROCHE -** Consistent type that trotted 3rd in a 3150m Saint-Brieuc Class F late last month. Won his only start under these conditions and, although not a priority, is not to be written off

**3. ILOT DU TRIEUX -** 5th to I LOVE IGNY (9) in a 2850m Mauquenchy Class F on 10 January but his main track results speak for themselves

**4. IDEAL DE DOMPIERRE -** Lost his action when well-supported in a Saint-Galmier Class E over 2650m last weekend. Is confirmed over track and trip and will not be far from the action if Anthony Barrier keeps him trotting

**5. ILDO DU VIVIER -** Sanctioned in a 2100m Class D here last September. Has not been seen out since and will need the run

**6. INDUCTIF** - Fine 2nd in a 2850m Class E here a month back. Untried over 2175m but is clearly close to his race and can give IVAN DU JAYLE (11) a run for his money

**7. IESOLO D'HERIPRE -** Facile winner of a 2700m Lyon-La Soie Class E on 12 January. Remarkably consistent when barefoot and, even though untried at Vincennes, he is very versatile and can figure prominently

**8. ISSI TOP -** Flew up over 2300m at home in Mons 10 days ago. Faces a much stiffer test on this occasion and unlikely to spring a surprise

**9. I LOVE IGNY -** Solid 2nd in a 2850m Mauquenchy Class F on 10 January. In better company this time but has references over 2175m here and should give an honest account

**10. IKILIK -** Got back in the game with 3rd in a 3000m Nantes Class D on 19 January. Has no particular love for Vincennes though and represents a minor place prospect at best

**11. IVAN DU JAYLE -** Won a 2650m Bordeaux Class F, shod, 3 weeks ago. Is new to the venue but has never been in better shape and can confirm his recent success

**12. ICARE D'ACADIE -** Decent type that finished unplaced on comeback in a 2875m Argentan Class F last weekend. Barefoot for 2nd start back and is capable of making the first 5

**Summary:** Winner of 2 of his last 3 starts, latterly with shoes on, IVAN DU JAYLE (11) races barefoot for his Vincennes debut and, although better going clockwise, he is very hard to ignore. Matthieu Abrivard can still expect to encounter resistance from INDUCTIF (6) who has pleased in 3 of his 4 main-track appearances, and IESOLO D'HERIPRE (7) who is a veritable dynamo these days when barefoot. IDEAL DE DOMPIERRE (4) may not be the easiest of horses to handle but he finished second under these conditions on Christmas Eve and, with application, will have his chances.

**2. GEISHA SPEED -** Respectable but unthreatening 6th in Gr.1 2700m Prix de Cornulier here 2 weeks ago and, while not cut from the same cloth as others here, will still have her supporters

**3. DYNASTY PEJI -** Sanctioned when never dangerous in Prix de Cornulier a fortnight back and can be confidently disregarded

**4. VAPRIO** - Disappointing 9th of 18 in the race of reference. 2nd to HANNA DES MOLLES (6) in 2023 edition but appears to have too much to do this time

**5. BLACKFLASH BAR -** Uninspiring last of 8 finishers on monté debut in Gr.2 over 2850m here on 7 January. Improvement anticipated but she is not going to shake things up

**6. HANNA DES MOLLES -** 3rd in 2023 Cornulier but below-par when 12th 2 weeks ago. Won the 2023 Prix de l'Ile-De-France and can be forgiven her Cornulier performance. Attention

**7. HIRONDELLE DU RIB** - Gave a superb account to finish 2nd, at 69/1, in Prix de Cornulier. Front pads fitted this time and, with her regular partner back in the saddle, will be no easy touch

**8. IDEALE DU CHENE -** Magnificent 3rd in Gr.1 Prix de Cornulier over 2700m a fortnight back. Has a good record over 2175m here and can make this her own

**9. GRANVILLAISE BLEUE -** Was not disgraced when 8th in the Cornulier. 3rd to HANNA DES MOLLES (6) in this event 12 months ago and looks considerably more dangerous than she did 2 weeks ago

**10. FLAMME DU GOUTIER -** Missed out on Cornulier hat-trick when 5th in the big race 2 weeks ago. Won Prix de l'IIe-de-France in 2021, looks to be in excellent shape, and is not incapable of adding another Gr.1 to her tally

**Summary:** Dual Gr.1 winner IDEALE DU CHENE (8) has been excellent under the saddle this winter and can bring home the bacon if she replicates her Cornulier run. There was no 3-timer for FLAMME DU GOUTIER (10) that day but she won this race 3 years ago and appears to be nearing her best. Biggest surprise in the Cornulier was the performance of HIRONDELLE DU RIB (7), at long odds, who will garner a lot more support this time around. GRANVILLAISE BLEUE (9) goes barefoot as she did in the Cornulier and should be in a position to challenge for a place on the podium this time.

**2. ISOLA QUICK -** Capable mare that lost her action in a Nantes Class F over 3000m late last month. Shoes on this time though and will have other priorities

**3. IN RACE LORRAINE -** 7th in a 2100m Vincennes Class E last Tuesday and is unlikely to improve much on that

**4. ISLA JUELA -** Missed out by a small margin for the 4-timer when 2nd in a 2850m Mauquenchy Class F 3 weeks ago. Like a horse reborn this winter and, on paper, should have this in the bag

**5. IRIS COURTOISE -** 3rd in a 2650m Bordeaux Class F mid-January, complementing her 2 previous runs, and although no fan of Vincennes, she is hard to ignore here

**6. INDIANAPOLIS -** Surprise 4th in a 2100m Class E here on 18 January despite being close to faulting. Has form under these conditions and, with application, can again make the first 5

**7. INES DE BEYLEV -** Made up for her mid-December clinker when 3rd in a 2850m Class E here on New Year's Eve. Confirmed over 2700m and looks a serious proposition

**8. I LOVE ROSE FLOWER -** Last of 13 in a 2850m Class D here on 23 January but is by some margin better than that and it is only a matter of time before she comes good again. Attention

**9. IDA D'ARRY -** 6th in a 2850m Mauquenchy monté Class F early last month. Has never delivered under harness over the main track and can be ruled out

**Summary:** With 3 wins and a 2nd place over the past 2 months, ISLA JUELA (4) has clearly never been better; she is unbeaten with Yoann Lebourgeois and looks set to return to winning ways. She could still encounter resistance from a revitalised INES DE BEYLEV (7) who had made the frame in 2 of her last 3 at this level, and I LOVE ROSE FLOWER (8) who is significantly better than recent results would suggest. IRIS COURTOISE (5) is back at her best and must be considered a reasonable place chance.

**4. GEORGES L'AVENTURE -** 6th of 12 in a 2175m Vincennes monté Class D 3 weeks ago. Has been struggling this winter and others easier to back

**5. GAYLORD AM -** 5th of 10 finishers over 2640m at Åby in early-December. Unseen since but is barefoot and well-positioned and should not be overlooked

**6. REVEN DEJAVU -** Sanctioned in a 2700m Saint-Galmier Class E last weekend after having pleased over 2700m here 11 days earlier and, from the front row, looks main threat to GLOBAL AGREEMENT (11)

**7. EXODUS BRICK** - Sanctioned in late-December race of reference. Showed his form at home before coming to France and, if focused, can trot his way onto the podium

**8. GO AWAY BIRD -** Made an excellent impact for new trainer when 3rd in a 2700m Cagnes Class E on 11 January. Shod differently this time and, with form maintained, could pleasantly surprise

**9. MISTER DONALD** - Oddly out of sorts when 9th of 16 over track and trip 2 months ago. Has not been seen out since but is barefoot for re-entry. Forced to break wide but can still pick up a cheque

**10. AXIS DI GIRIFALCO** - 4th over 1650m in Milan on Christmas Eve. Sports a new configuration for Vincennes debut but looks a minor place chance at best this time

**11. GLOBAL AGREEMENT** - Made short work of his Vincennes debut, winning superbly under these conditions on 29 December. Handed a second-line draw but still looks the pick of the field

**12. GALOPIN DE BLOT -** 6th in a 2700m Lyon-La Soie Class E against older horses 3 weeks ago. Has no Vincennes references though and the draw will not help his plight

**13. SILVER BULLIT(SWE)** - Showed marked improvement in a Toulouse Class D over 2950m 3 weeks ago. Never easy to gauge but is reunited with Eric Raffin and can get a look-in

**14. GUIDO JOSSELYN** - 6th in a Vincennes monté Class D over 2700m on 18 January. Barefoot on this occasion but others still preferred

**15. GARRY THORIS -** 2nd in a claimer over course and distance just last Tuesday. Races barefoot this time but still seems to be biting off more than he can chew

**16. GREAT D'ARRY -** Sanctioned in a 4125m Class E here late last month. Handed a shocking draw and, in this company, is unlikely to influence the result

**Summary:** Twice a winner in Italy before flying up under these conditions on his French debut here, GLOBAL AGREEMENT (11) is not ideally-placed on the back row but he still gets the nod ahead of the consistent REVEN DEJAVU (6) who similarly left a good impression on his first Vincennes start. Rested for 2 months after debuting nicely here in early-December, FRODO S (2) sports a new configuration and, from the 2-spot, will be competitive for a place in the frame. EXODUS BRICK (7) was quickly sanctioned behind the favourite here in late-December but, with a new formula and Mathieu Mottier reining, can put things right.

**4. KALAMITY DE CHENU** - Defied her odds to come 2nd in a Class E over track and trip a fortnight ago although she will struggle to repeat

**5. KYARA** - Sanctioned in a Vincennes claimer over 2875m a fortnight back and, in this category, can be confidently ruled out

**6. KALINE DJOB** - Finished [4th] a place behind KENZA D'AMOUR (14) in a 2100m Vincennes Class D mid-January and will not be sent out at 54/1 on this occasion

**7. KAGNOTTE D'AZIF** - Tricky type that showed improvement when 3rd in a Class D over course and distance last weekend and François Lagadeuc will be out to prove it was not a flash in the pan

**8. KEYSTONE -** Delicate filly that came in 6th of 16 in a Class D over 2100m here mid-January after having won over track and trip and can figure prominently if she gets off on the right foot

**9. KADIX DEL PHEDO** - Still a maiden but reassured when 3rd in a Class D over track and trip on 25 December. Is first time barefoot and, although not a priority, will still be worth monitoring

**10. KLOE DU ROUEZO -** Scored her third success in a Class E over 2850m on Boxing Day and, a similar performance would see her wrap this up

**11. KATINKA AIMEF** - Won a 2200m Vincennes monté Class E in mid-January. Keeps on improving and, while unlikely to secure the 3-timer, should still acquit herself competitively

**Summary:** A promising future prospect, KLOE DU ROUEZO (10) has won 3 of 4 starts to date, most recently imposed magnificently over the short course, and should confirm provided she takes to the new profile. Winner over course and distance in late-November before faulting next time, KALINE DU JOUR (3) has had time to get her house in order and can set the record straight. Although unplaced on her lone Vincennes appearance, KOUSINE CARISAIE (15) has otherwise been superb over recent months and, more competitively-shod this time, is not going down without a fight. Winner in both codes over recent weeks, KATINKA AIMEF (11) is barefoot as she bids for the hat-trick but may have to settle for a place cheque this time around.
