- **1. KUMBI DE PHYT'S -** 10th in the race of reference. Has been a total write-off for some time and can be confidently disregarded
- 2. KRONOS DU GITE 3rd in a 2175m Vincennes monté Class E last week. Not without merit at this level but faces a stiffer test on this occasion
- **3. JIPSY ROYALE -** 10th of 12 in a 2700m Lyon-la Soie Class D last week. Has yet to make her mark in the claiming division and is unlikely to influence the result
- **4. KALINKA DU BLEUET -** Honest filly that left a good impression when 5th to KALIKA DU RIS (9) late last month and, although not a priority, she races on level terms this time and can finish in the mix
- **5. JORLANDO -** 3rd to JAHA MAN DU PONT (12) in a 2100m claimer here last Saturday. Is clearly back in business since taking a dip in category and has a reasonable chance of making the frame
- **6. JOULYO VITA -** Unraced since losing his action in a 2725m Cabourg Class E on 21 December. Would have gone close that day though and must be afforded respect
- 7. KIWI DES MALBERAUX Finished a one-paced 8th of 10 finishers in the race of reference. Placed over track and trip at the turn of the year though and should not be written off

And stablemate KALIKA DU RIS (9) finished a close 2nd that day on her first appearance in the claiming category and, with form maintained, could well trot off with the silverware. JAHA MAN DU PONT (12) went one better on his claiming debut and, even in the absence of JMB, still looks to have a respectable claim. JUNKO SEPT (10) showed improvement in better company last week and drops back in class with legitimate ambition.

- 2. IRINA DU RIS Non partante
- 3. ILVICA DE HOUELLE Never dangerous when 7th behind IKURO JIEL (10) in a Class C under these conditions 10 days ago and, in current condition, appears to have no chance
- **4. IN LOVE DE BLARY -** Prepped for this when last of 9 in a Pontchâteau harness Class E over 2800m on 5 January. Won at the start of the winter meeting and can get a look-in if François Lagadeuc keeps her trotting
- **5. IMBRIN BUROIS -** 8th of 9 behind IL TROTTE JARL (9) in a course-and-distance Class E on Christmas Eve after having won a level down 11 days earlier. In this company though, is unlikely to spring any surprises
- **6. ILIEN DE VRIE -** Runner-up to ISLAMORADA (13) in the late-January race of reference. Like a horse reborn lately and it will not be long before he gets back in the winners' circle
- 7. ILLICO DE LOU Showed marked improvement when 3rd in a 2825m Cordemais Class E just over 3 weeks ago and, in similar form, can make the first five
- **8. IRIS INTENSE** Lost his action in a 2350m Angers Class D under harness a month back. Yet to make his mark in this code but has the capacity and, with David Thomain onboard, can be assured a competitive ride
- 9. IL TROTTE JARL Courageous 4th [to ILLICO DE LOU (7)] in a 2825m Cordemais Class E on 17 January. Is plainly in decent shape, has previously beaten others here, but will need to bring more than his A-game this time
- 10. IKURO JIEL Unexceptional but decent 5th in a Class C over track and trip on 30 January. Always gives his best but appears to be facing a stiffer test this time around

- **18. ILONA DES MOYEUX -** 10th of 11 finishers in a 2850m Vincennes harness Class C on comeback 3 weeks ago. Is no easy touch when unshod but has just one race in him and risks being rusty

Summary: A number of horses in contention here but given how well ISLAMORADA (13) has been performing lately under these conditions, it is hard to rule out the winter hat-trick. That said, IRINA DU RIS (2) is no slouch when focused and can give her a run for her money if Mathieu Mottier gets her off on the right foot. Runner-up to the favourite here last time out, ILIEN DE VRIE (6) is capable of making the frame once more, as does the in-form ISLAND LOVE (14) who drops in category for her first appearance under the saddle since June 2022.

- **2. JUSQUINE FOUTEAU -** Pleased twice over course and distance this winter but will need to improve on her 7th of 10 in a 2700m Vincennes Class D on 22 January
- **3. JET SOCIETY -** Lost her action in a 2700m Vincennes Class D on 22 January but showed her form 6 days earlier and, on good behaviour, can make amends and finish close
- **4. JAFLOSA GIRL -** Takes a drop in class after finishing a well-beaten 6th of 7 in a 2700m Class B here 3 weeks ago. Is well-placed behind the car but others still preferred
- **5. JULOHA STAR ELGE -** Showed improvement when 2nd in a 2750m Cabourg Class E early last month but has placed just once in 5 over the main track and appears to have too much to do

- **2. GOLD DE JADE -** Sanctioned in a 3000m Nantes harness Class E on his first start since November 2021. If race-fit and focused, he will be no pushover
- **3. GROUND ZERO -** Failed to confirm his good Croisé-Laroche performance when 7th of 10 finishers in a 2175m Class E here on New Year's Eve. Has never delivered when unshod behind and is not about to change his ways
- **4. GALLAGHER WIND -** Returns to the monté discipline after finishing last of 12 in a 2750m Toulouse harness Class E and is unlikely to spring any surprises
- **5. GACHETTE MONTAVAL** 5th of 14 in a 3000m Châteaubriant Class F on 21 January. Has demonstrated very good aptitude for the code recently and the revised configuration may well do just the trick. First 5 prospect
- **6. GRAND TRIO LUDOIS -** 6th, when shod and being conditioned, in a 3125m Angers Class F 9 days ago. Faces first objective of the new season and, barefoot this time, will be worth keeping an eye on

- **3. KEEP TIME -** 11th of 15 in a 2850m Vincennes Class D when being conditioned, shod, late last month. Barefoot this time and, from the 3-spot, can open his 2024 account
- **4. KOPECK DE CHENU -** Got off the mark with authority in a 2625m Agen-Le Passage Class C late last month. Takes on better this time but races first-time barefoot and from the 4-spot can play a role
- **5. KAMIL VAN HALBEEK** Left a fine impression on Vincennes debut in a Class D over course and distance. Ideally-engaged this time and can return to winning ways

- **3. KEVA MADRIK** Finished [4th] a place behind KAWASAKI ERA (6) in a 2700m Vincennes Class D late last month but still has a lot more to find
- **4. KADIMA ERA -** Authoritative Class E winner over track and trip 10 days ago. Adrien Lamy takes over in the irons and looks to have a live chance on his hands
- **5. KIBBLE -** Took advantage of numerous disqualifications to finish a flattering 4th in a Class C over 2700m here on 14 January and others preferred
- **6. KAWASAKI ERA -** Consistent type that finished a pleasant 3rd in a 2700m Vincennes Class D late last month and represents a decent first-5 chance

Enjoying something of a renaissance this year, HURELLA (5) is barefoot for the occasion and is unlikely to disappoint. Seen more often under the saddle this winter, GOLD VOICE (14) can nevertheless boast excellent Vincennes references and the change of discipline may be just what the doctor ordered.
