1. KING GEORGES - Sanctioned in both return runs, most recently a Class C over course and distance, and needs to get his house in order

2. KEROS DES BAUX - Encouraging 4th, behind KATIM DU GOUTIER (5), in a Class C over track and trip a fortnight back, but still has a lot of ground to make up

3. KEROSEN DU GERS - Steps up in category after winning 3 in the space of 5 weeks, latterly a Class D over course and distance 3 weeks ago, and looks main threat to KEEP YOUR DREAMS (11)

4. KRAKEN CASTELETS - Unseen since coming 6th, behind KYOTO DIGEO (6), in a 2100m Vincennes Class A on 22 February. Honest type but never closer than 5th in this category and is unlikely to shake things up

5. KATIM DU GOUTIER - Seldom gets her nose in front but has placed twice in last 3, latterly 3rd in a Class C under these conditions 2 weeks ago and, front pads fitted this time, should be good enough to make the first 5

6. KYOTO DIGEO - Never far from springing a surprise but latest 9th of 11 in a 2850m Class A here 3 weeks ago did little to impress. Sports front pads this time though and could get a look-in

7. KEMIA DU CHENE - Highly-consistent filly making her first appearance since trotting 2nd of 9 in a similar event here 3 months ago. Shoes on and best to hold off

8. KIPHYLE DESBOIS - Consistent for the most part but did not enjoy the best of runs when 7th in a 2850m Class A here 3 weeks ago, and will be expected to make amends. Place chance

9. KIRCIE DE GUEZ - Unseen since winning a 2175m monté Class B here late-December. Here for reasons of conditioning and will pose no danger

10. KRACOVIA - Quality filly that was sanctioned in a 2850m Class A here 3 weeks ago. Champion driver at the helm this time and can start to come good again. Place chance

11. KEEP YOUR DREAMS - Superb last season but capricious lately, most recently pulled-up in a 2700m Gr.3 here early last month. Debuts for new trainer however and the change of scenery may be just what he needed. Claim

12. KAPORAL DES FORGES - On a decent run of late, finishing 3rd of 9 in a Class A over track and trip on 23 March, and again looks competitively well-in

Summary: A classy individual but nevertheless a handful over recent weeks, KEEP YOUR DREAMS (11) races unshod-behind on his first start for Julien Dubois and will be dangerous if he can stay in stride. KEROSEN DU GERS (3) has come on leaps and bounds lately and steps up in class with justified ambition. A winner under these conditions over the winter, KAPORAL DES FORGES (12) left a good impression over course and distance last month and can finish closer this time. JMB hands the reins to the complicated KRACOVIA (10) over to Eric Raffin for the first time and she will have a lot to offer if he can keep her trotting.

2. JUPITER TURGOT - Has started to come good again this year, most recently close 2nd in a 2100m Class D here 2 weeks ago, setting personal best time, and looks main danger to JOKER DE CHOISEL (6)

3. JOUR DE FETE - Unraced since finishing 6th of 10 in a Class C over course and distance mid-February. Shoes on and can be passed over

4. JUNIOR ANGELE - Dependable trotter that gave an excellent account when 3rd to JOB DES MOLLES (11) in a 2450m Caen Class D on 21 March. Will have come on for the run and will be no pushover

5. JUDICIEUX - Tricky but classy element that came 6th in a 2850m Class C here a week ago. Will be fully-fit and is capable of trotting his way into the frame this time

6. JOKER DE CHOISEL - Unbeaten in 3 starts this year, latterly over course and distance on 22 March. Entrusted to Eric Raffin for just the 2nd time but nevertheless has every chance of completing the 4-timer

7. JUBY DE BAILLY - Lost his action in a 2700m Vincennes monté Class C 10 days ago. Here for a change of scenery and can expect to have few friends

8. JOLLY STAR JIEL - Picked up this year where she left off last season, latterly 9th of 10 in a 2100m Vincennes Class C earlier in the month, and has no realistic chance

9. JUST D'ERONVILLE - Trotted 5th over course and distance last month before dominating a 2700m Lyon-La Soie Class D on 10 April. Is unlikely to repeat but can still figure prominently

10. JASON GINYU - 8th of 12, at 139/1, in a 2450m Caen Class B on 11 March on first appearance since December. Races barefoot this time but others still preferred

11. JOB DES MOLLES - 11th of 14 in a 2100m Class C here on 6 April, due in no small part to the draw. Has otherwise been in cracking form and will be significantly more competitive on this occasion

12. JASMIN BLANC - 2nd in a 2700m Lyon-La Soie Class F on 28 March. Has shown little love for Vincennes since the winter but is ideally-entered and will generate some interest

Summary: Already well-regarded, JOKER DE CHOISEL (6) has taken his game to a new level this year and even though in a more elevated category this time, still looks the one to beat. Fourth to him over course and distance last month JUPITER TURGOT (2) did not miss out by much here a fortnight ago and will be competitive for the win this time. JUDICIEUX (5) is not everyone's cup of tea but he has two races in him and is competitively-shod. JUNIOR ANGELE (4) consistently gives his best, impressed on re-entry, and must be afforded respect.

1. KANTHABELLA - Well-beaten 4th of 5 in a 2700m Class B here earlier in the month and is unlikely to spring a surprise

2. KETTY ANGOT - 4th of 8, on first start since the spell, in a 2700m harness Class C here on 9 April. Is biting off more than she can chew and can be confidently passed over

3. KUNG FU QUICK - Met little opposition en route to victory in a 2500m Reims harness Class D 9 days ago. Makes just 2nd start in the monté discipline and, with Benjamin Rochard on board, will be no easy touch

4. KATINKA AIMEF - Facile winner of a 2700m Class B here 3 weeks ago. Unbeaten in 4 starts with Eric Raffin in the irons and, even in this elevated category, will have her chances

5. KIMBO BERRY - Sanctioned in a 2700m Class A here, when never dangerous, a fortnight ago, and can expect to have few takers

6. KAPAULA DE L'EPINE - Twice a Gr.2 winner over the winter but sanctioned in last 4, most recently Gr.1 Prix des Centaures, but sports modified shoeing and can play a role if Adrien Lamy gets her off on the right foot

7. KARLA DE MAI - Placed in 2 Gr.2's before coming 7th of 10 finishers in Gr.1 Prix des Centaures in early-March. Has had time to freshen up and can challenge for a spot on the podium

8. KABAKA DE GUEZ - 7th of 10 in a 2875m Enghien harness Gr.2 last weekend. No champion but always gives her best, sports a new configuration, but will still need to find more

9. KYT KAT - Went off the boil in latter half of 2023 after having dominated the discipline. Unraced since trotting 7th to KAPAULA DE L'EPINE (6) in a Gr.2 over course and distance early-December. Has a lot going for him and can get straight back in the game

10. KYRIELLE DES VAUX - Wonderful campaigner making her first appearance since winning Gr.2 over 2850m here 2.5 months ago. First time barefoot and will take all the beating

Summary: Simply superb over the winter, KYRIELLE DES VAUX (10) was sent for a spell after comfortably winning the Gr.2 Prix Louis le Bourg early-February; she returns to Vincennes barefoot for the first time and looks the obvious choice. KUNG FU QUICK (3) was sanctioned on his lone monté appearance but is barefoot and most certainly here on his merits. Already a winner at the highest level, KYT KAT (9) has had time to get his house in order and, competitively-shod for re-entry, should not disappoint. Unbeaten in his last 4 monté starts, KATINKA AIMEF (4) excels with Eric Raffin and steps up in class with a good hand to play.

2. ISIS D'HERFRAIE - Convincing winner of a 2350m Angers Class E earlier this month. Thrives in this configuration and the draw will only enhance her prospects. Chance

3. HARMONIE DE BREVOL - Sanctioned in last 2, most recently when well-supported in a 2550m Reims Class D 9 days ago. Has a good spot behind the car but others still easier to trust

4. HARENA DE MARZY - 4th to ISIS D'HERFRAIE (2) in a 2350m Angers Class E on 3 April. Races barefoot this time, is confirmed under these conditions and breaking from the 4-spot will do her prospects no disservice

5. ISLA MUJERES - 5th, behind GONNABE SHADOW (13), in a 2875m Enghien Class D last week and appears to be taking on too big a task this time

6. CANADIAN KRONOS - Oddly below-par when 12th of 13 in a 2700m Class C here on 23 March. Placed in a Gr.3 under similar conditions earlier in the year, has excellent speed, and can make this her own

7. HISTORY MAJYC - Made up for last month's incident with victory in a 2600m Nancy Class F mid-month. Won over track and trip, in style, 2 months ago and has a realistic opportunity of confirming

8. GIANA DE MARZY - Won well at Châtelaillon-La Rochelle last month before coming a decent 6th to ISIS D'HERFRAIE (2) in a 2350m Angers Class E on 3 April, but under these conditions will have her work cut out

9. HISTOIREMIKA - 6th of 16 in a 2700m Class F at Le Croisé-Laroche on 15 April. Appreciates the Vincennes main track and will not be far off the mark if François Lecanu can defy the draw

10. MAGGIORE (SWE) - Won over 2350m at Avenches mid-month. Has never shown much liking for the Vincennes main track but Matthieu Abrivard will still give this a good go, but perhaps with limited aspirations

11. MUSETT AF DJUPMYRA - Last of 14 in a Class B over course and distance 2 weeks ago. Shoes off this time but still not an obvious choice

12. HEXCELLENTE - 10th in a 2875m Enghien Class D 8 days ago. Kicked 2024 off with course and distance victory though and, with 4 pads fitted, is unlikely to be far from the action

13. GONNABE SHADOW - Runner-up in 2 of 3 since coming to France, latterly a 2875m Enghien Class D last week. Has solid references over these shorter trips and, despite a 2nd line draw, is not incapable of shaking things up

14. ILIADE (SWE) - Surprise 5th, at 51/1, in a 2150m Argentan Class D on 15 April. Barefoot this time but has been handed an unfavourable draw and will struggle to make her mark

Summary: A faithful servant for the most part, CANADIAN KRONOS (6) returns to conditions under which she thrives and with the champion driver reining, should have the measure of the field. That said, ISIS D'HERFRAIE (2) has a somewhat better draw, is at the top of her game, and will be no shrinking violet. HISTORY MAJYC (7) was sensational over course and distance two months ago and most recently showed her form at Nancy. HEXCELLENTE (12) is forced to break from the back row but is twice a winner over course and distance and, fitted with 4 pads this time, will be no easy touch.

2. NINEPOINTS LASSE - Complicated type that finished 5th in a 2500m Reims Class F 9 days ago. Raced better than the result would suggest and, with Eric Raffin reining, will be afforded every chance. Attention

3. CHITCHAT - Good Swedish import dropping back in trip after coming 3rd, a place behind BITCOIND'ARC (5) in a 2700m Vincennes Class D a week ago, and looks capable of turning the tables

4. INVICTUS MADRIK - 8th of 9 finishers in a 2850m Vincennes Class E 3 weeks ago. Has yet to find his feet this term but the draw will do his prospects no harm

5. BITCOIND'ARC - 2nd of 11 in a 2700m Vincennes Class D a week ago. Won over course and distance earlier in the year and is sufficiently well-positioned to take on CHITCHAT (3) for the spoils

6. IGGYPOP D'HERFRAIE - Comes here on a hat-trick following victory in a 2800m Class F at Villedieu-les-Poëles on 1 April. Has solid Vincennes credentials but, in this company, looks more a minor place prospect

7. INDUS VAL - Back at the top of his game with 2 straight successes, most recently a 2000m Lyon-Parilly Class E on 2 April and, while unlikely to pull of the hat-trick, will still be competitive for a place in the first 5

8. LUCKY GUY BOKO - Remarkably-consistent campaigner that missed out by little in a 2500m Reims Class F on 17 April. Has not put a foot wrong since coming to France and, despite the wide start, still looks a serious proposition

9. CROIZEROSS - Has struggled since coming to France, most recently 9th of 11 finishers in Reims race of reference, and can expect to have few friends

10. NEVELE HALL GRAUX - Surprise 4th, at 63/1, in 17 April race of reference, but a repeat seems improbable

11. OSCAR VAN HALBEEK - Won over 2840m at Mons 10 days ago. Has been hard to fault for some time, but races shod on this occasion and others easier to support

12. INVADER AM - 10th to BITCOIND'ARC (5) in a 2700m Class C here on 22 March. Races barefoot this time but still has too much to find

13. JACK IS BACK - Returns to the harness code after coming 2nd in a 2750m monté Class F at La Capelle on 7 April. Just front shoes off this time and can be passed over

14. LET IT BE VP - Has yet to find his mark since leaving Sweden, most recently sanctioned early in Reims race of reference, and others easier to back

15. DJANGO SILVER - 9th of 11, on return to racing, in a 2700m Vincennes Class D a week ago, and the draw only compounds matters

16. ONE LOVE BIANCA - Faithful servant that came 2nd, at 34/1, in a Class C over course and distance 3 weeks ago. Is behind in earnings, has excellent speed and, if still on the boil, can figure prominently at the business end of the race

Summary: A trotter of considerable quality, the Swedish-trained CHITCHAT (3) has taken well to French conditions, put on quite the show behind the in-form BITCOIND'ARC (5) last week and, with Gabriele Gelormini reining this time, can exact revenge. LUCKY GUY BOKO (8) has form against his compatriot and, even though drawn wide, has not once finished out of the first 3 since coming south. ONE LOVE BIANCA (16) has been handed a rough draw but he impressed here earlier in the month and will have his chances if Alexis Collette successfully navigates the start.

2. JALOUSIE DE L'ISLE - 7th of 8 finishers in a 2850m Vincennes Class C when preparing for this a week ago, and already looks out of her depth

3. JENY LOVE JEPHI - 7th of 8, to JUS DE FRUIT (4), in a 2700m Class C here 10 days ago and will struggle to make her presence felt

4. JUS DE FRUIT - Winner of a 2700m Vincennes Class C 10 days ago. Steps back up in class but is plainly at his best and is not incapable of making the frame

5. JEROBOAM D'ERABLE - Runner-up in a 2700m Gr.2 before trotting 4th, with shoes on, a place behind JULIANA DE RETZ (8), in a 2700m Class A here a fortnight ago. Shod to preference this time and can give JANE AIMEE (6) something to think about

6. JANE AIMEE - 2nd in a 2850m Lyon-Parilly harness Class D when prepping for this on 2 April. Is first-time barefoot and, with Raffin in the irons, should have the race at her mercy

7. JUNE - Produced her career-best effort when 4th in a 2175m Gr.2 late-January. Has not been seen out since but is barefoot for comeback and should not be ruled out

8. JULIANA DE RETZ - In the frame in last 2, most recently 3rd in a 2700m Class A here on 12 April, and while not a priority, should nonetheless acquit herself honourably

9. JINGLE DELO - Faulted in a 2875m Enghien harness Class A, when clearly full of running, last weekend. Has never finished a monté event unscathed but Jean-Philippe Raffegeau does not present him here for folly. Attention

10. JESSY DE BANVILLE - Last of 11 when prepping for this in a 2700m harness Gr.2 here 2 weeks ago. Has nothing to prove at this level and, competitively-shod this time, will be no soft touch

Summary: After a brace of harness fresheners, JANE AIMEE (6) makes her first appearance under the saddle since trotting 3rd in Gr.1 Prix des Elites and, barefoot and entrusted to Eric Raffin for the first time, should be able to wrap this up. She will still meet resistance from JEROBOAM D'ERABLE (5) who is shod as he was when 2nd in Gr.2 Prix Paul Bastard, and the favourite's stablemate and Gr.1-winning, JESSY DE BANVILLE (10) who is shod to preference for her first goal of the new season. 2. KASH QUICK - Progressive sort that has won 3 from 5, latterly 2nd to KOMDAPI DIESCHOOT (10) in a 2850m Laval Class E late last month and, with front pads fitted, could yet exact revenge

3. KAZACHOK D'ETANG - Respectable 5th of 10 finishers in a 2100m Class D here 2 weeks ago. Is confirmed under these conditions but will still need to raise his game

4. KOOL DU PORHOET - Has not been seen out since faulting in a 2175m Class D here on 18 January and can be confidently passed over

5. KAYNE RICHER - 4th of 11, at 45/1, in a Class E over course and distance a week ago. Steps up in category but can play a part if still on the boil

6. KINGSTON DU BOURG - Twice runner-up before finishing 10th behind KOBALT (9) in a 2875m Argentan Class E mid-month. Is a different horse when barefoot and is worth keeping an eye on

7. KAP PAASLOO - Makes Vincennes debut after coming 2nd over 2600m at Wolvega on his first start since the break. Hind shoes off for the occasion but still faces a stiff test

8. KANEM - Tenacious winner of a 2750m Class E at La Capelle on 7 April. In better company this time but form is clearly headed in the right direction and he is not to be underestimated

9. KOBALT - 6th of 13 when prepping shod for this in a 2875m Argentan Class E mid-month. Barefoot for metropolitan debut and should be good enough to challenge for a place in the frame

10. KOMDAPI DIESCHOOT - Good class of trotter that won a 2850m Laval Class E late last month when first time barefoot. Shoes off again and can make a big impact if he takes to the new profile

11. KITTS ET NEVIS - Would have won a 2700m Class D here late last month had he not lost his action. Has bags of ability, sports a new configuration, and looks set to take all the beating

12. KENOR DESBOIS - 7th of 12 finishers, on re-entry, in a 2875m Argentan Class E 11 days ago. Is still being conditioned and not a priority

Summary: A complicated sort he might be but the potential KITTS ET NEVIS (11) has displayed is undeniable; he showed his form here last month despite faulting, sports front pads for the first time, and Yoann Lebourgeois will be loathe to let the same thing happen twice. He can nevertheless expect to encounter resistance from recent Laval winner, KOMDAPI DIESCHOOT (10), who is barefoot again in search of the double, and the improving KASH QUICK (2) who sports front pads for his Vincennes bow. 3. GALION - 5th of 13, at 70/1 on re-entry, in a 2850m Mauquenchy Class F on 4 April. Goes barefoot this time and although not a leading contender, should at least still hold his own

4. GAGNEUR - Reliability not his strong suit but encouraged when 3rd of 13 in a 2825m Chartres Class F. Shoes on again but others still preferred

5. HETRE D'OURVILLE - Won over course and distance before trotting 5th of 17 in a 2875m Argentan Class F midmonth. Starts in front and repeating last month's success is a distinct possibility

6. FRANCO FLEURI - Winner of a 2800m Carhaix Class F earlier in the month, complementing his previously good runs, but will need to find significantly more

7. GAZELLE DE VAL - 10th of 15, on first start since the break, in a 3125m Angers Class F on 11 April. Has decent maintrack references but other more attractive options are available

8. HIMBERLAND - Regressing somewhat of late, most recently 9th of 15 in a 3125m Angers Class F a fortnight back, and will struggle to make any impact

9. HOVE PONT VAUTIER - Sanctioned, for the 2nd straight time, in a 2100m Vincennes Class C earlier this month. Has nothing to prove in this category though and, on good behaviour, can set the record straight

10. HARVEST DE BULIERE - 2nd in a 2850m Lyon-Parilly Class D late-March. Has done nothing but improve lately and, even from the 2nd line, is unlikely to be far from the action

11. GIMS DU PLESSIS - Disappointing 10th of 15 in a Class D over course and distance a fortnight back. Raffin has maintained faith though and will be out to put things right. Claim

12. GAULTHERIA - Unplaced in last 2, most recently 8th of 15 in a similar event here 2 weeks ago. Has references at this level and, with Gelormini reining, can get back in the game

13. EXTRA DU CHATELET - Has twice failed to replicate his good Enghien performance, latterly 9th of 12 finishers in a 2100m Class C here 3 weeks ago, and can be passed over

14. HOLERO LOVE - Quality individual making first appearance since faulting in a 2700m Class A here early-November. Barefoot for the occasion though and, if applied, can play a small part

15. GALON DE VIRE - 14th of 15 on comeback 2 weeks ago in a Class D over course and distance, picking up where he left off, and can be ruled out

16. FOREVER JIEL - Moderate 6th of 14 in a 2550m Reims Class D 9 days ago. Incurs the penalty again and others easier to back

Summary: Third to the excellent Ino Du Lupin earlier in the year, HOVE PONT VAUTIER (9) has been showing his temperament lately but nonetheless has the wherewithal to win this, provided Paul Ploquin keeps him trotting. Winner of a similar event a month ago, HETRE D'OURVILLE (5) gets a 25m head-start and will be expected to apply the pressure, as will GIMS DU PLESSIS (11) whose return to form is just a question of time.
