- 2. JODLEUSE MAG Has really struggled this year and was disqualified last time out at La Capelle on 10 May. Very unlikely to win
- **3. JUMBY BAY -** Bounced back to form with a solid runner-up performance last time out in Class D at this course over 2700m on 6 April. Can contest the finish again
- **4. JADE D'ERABLE -** In good form and was third last time out in Class D at this course over 2700m on 6 April. Not out of it
- **5. JADE VENESI -** More than a year since last win but has been in good form of late and was third last time out in Class E at Vichy over 2950m on 12 May. Might play a minor role

- **3. L'AS DESBOIS -** Fluffed his lines with a disqualification at this course last time out on 30 April. in good form before that and can contest the finish
- **4. LORD DE BANVILLE -** Yet to win but was not disgraced when fourth last time out in Class A over this track and trip on 30 April. Has disgualification issues but could play a minor role
- **5. LOVELY TRIP -** Disqualified last time out at Caen on 11 May. In good form before that and has a place chance
- **6. LOOPING DAY -** A winner of two of his four starts, with his latest win being in Class C at Vichy over 2150m on 13 May. Capable of making the frame
- **7. LOOK MESLOIS -** Has major disqualification issues and was disqualified last time out at this course on 30 April. Talented and can bounce back to score if smart

- **4. LUCY LIGNERIES -** Disqualified in her first two starts and was 8th last time out in a Class F harness race at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2875m on 13 May. Needs major improvement to win
- **5. LEA DE FROULAY -** Disqualified in all three harness races but did show vast improvement when third last time out in a Class E Mounted race at Maure-de-Bretagne over 2250m on 12 May. Might place
