- **3. KOQUIN D'AMOUR -** Usually gives of his best and finished fourth in class C over this track and trip on 15 October. Returns from a break but is not out of it if fit
- 4. KASSIDY KID Disqualified at this track on 12 January. Battling to find best form and others are preferred
