- **3. DIE HARD (ITY) -** On a very long losing run and was 7th in Class E at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2850m on 13 January. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- **4. OSCAR VAN HALBEEK -** In good form and finished third last time out in Class D over this track and trip on 28 January. Not out of it
- **5. KINGSLAYER PELLINI** Disappointing form of late and was 7th in Class C over this track and trip on 30 January. Capable of doing better and has a place chance

- **16. JOUR DE FETE -** Only fair of late and finished 5th in Class B at this track over 2700m on 4 February. Could earn some minor money

Summary: H.C.'S CRAZY HORSE (15) did show last time over the course & distance what he is capable of and should confirm this good impression. MATEO DI QUATTRO (11) has shown plenty of ability in Sweden and can make a big impact on his first run on French soil. DENCO'S GALLIANO (6) was very unlucky in the running in his last outing and is expected to go much closer this time around. The consistent JOLIVERT DU GERS (12) seldom wins but can run in a place once again. SIDNEY CELEBER (10) and Eric Raffin will have their supporters.
