- **1. KARLOS NAY -** Has progressed nicely this year, most recently winning a 2700m Machecoul Class F mid-March. Is new to Vincennes but his driver is not. First 5
- **2. KOULOU GAGOU -** Sanctioned in a 2725m Graignes Class E mid-March. Mathieu Mottier in the bike this time but still can't be considered a priority
- **3. KIWI DE BAFFAIS -** Comfortable winner of a 2200m Caen Class F a month ago. Takes on a tougher lot this time but can still pick up some scraps
- **4. KABIR BEDI -** Was competitive when sanctioned on comeback in a 2475m Royan Class E last Sunday. Boss in the bike this time and can win this if he keeps his charge focused
- **5. KAID FORTUNA -** In the frame in last 3, most recently 3rd of 13 in a 2750m Class E at La Capelle last weekend. Has placed just once in 4 over main track though and others easier to support
- **6. KONOR HIGHLAND -** Below-par so far in 2025, latterly sanctioned in a 2650m Marseille-Vivaux Class E a fortnight ago, and will have few friends
- **7. KARMA TEJY -** Ran 2nd at Graignes before being sanctioned in a 2650m Laval Class E last Sunday and has a lot to find
- **8. KONAN JERSEY -** Reassuring 3rd of 18 in a 2875m Meslay-du-Maine Class F on 18 March. Reconfigured this time but is still worth keeping an eye on
- **9. KARAT DEFF** Returns to Vincennes after securing a 2450m Caen Class D on 20 March. Has placed just once here but in current condition is easy to recommend
- **10. KONG D'HOLLOW -** Won both since his return from a break, latterly from pillar to post in a 2600m Nancy Class E 2 weeks ago, and even with shoes fitted, looks a serious proposition
- **11. KANAK DU BOCAGE -** Pleasant 3rd of 16 in a 2825m Cordemais Class F a fortnight ago. Shoes off this time though and, given the entry, is unlikely to disappoint

Summary: KANAK DU BOCAGE (11) has been in good shape recently, benefits from an Eric Raffin-drive and a good entry, and is in with a shout of picking up his 2nd success of the year. They can nevertheless expect to come under fire from the similarly well-engaged KONG D'HOLLOW (10) who goes shod in a bid to secure his first hat-trick, and the complicated KABIR BEDI (4) who excels with Jean-Michel Bazire reining. Although not the biggest Vincennes fan, KARAT DEFF (9) is also nicely-entered, is clearly in excellent form, and warrants considerable respect.

- **2. MONEY CASH -** Has not been seen out since being sanctioned in a 2700m Class B here last November and is going to need the race
- **3. MADE IN MARETTES -** Bit off more than he could chew on comeback, running 6th of 8 finishers behind MARZIPAN (10) in a 2700m Gr.3 here 2 weeks ago. The run will have done him good but is not expected to shake things up
- **4. MISTRAL CASTELLE -** Given a short rest after winning a 2200m Class C here, at 26/1, on 30 January. Paul Ploquin reining this time but still not an obvious choice
- **5. MISTER FOURCADE -** Failed to confirm Cagnes success when 5th of 9 behind MY NAME IS BOND (11) in a 2700m Class A here 2 months ago. Eric Raffin back in the bike but others still easier to back
- **6. MAESTRO JAMINI -** Useful type that was surprisingly below-par when 7th of 9 behind MY NAME IS BOND (11) in a 2700m Class A here 2 months ago. Is clearly better than that and should not be ruled out
- **7. MUST ATOUT -** Made short work of a 2150m Enghien Class D early last month. Is never far from faulting but has bags of ability and with application will not be far off the mark
- **8. MEWTWO -** Interesting future prospect making first appearance since trouncing the opposition in a 2100m Class C here in November and will not be given a hard race
- **9. MONTEQUILLO -** Looked thoroughly professional when comfortably winning a 2700m Class C here on 20 February. Will have been specifically prepared for this and can make it 2 on the trot

Sanctioned more often than not, MAESTRO VRIE (13) will have come on for his return run and will be no pushover if Alexandre Abrivard keeps him trotting. MARZIPAN (10) also drops down the class-ladder but is plainly in shape and is due a win one of these days. MUST ATOUT (7) makes his first appearance over the long course after having romped across town last month and will have his chances if he takes to the new profile.

- **3. LUGANO DE LOU -** Lost his action when going well in a 2100m Class C here 3 weeks ago. Ability is not in doubt though and will be no pushover if he stays in stride
- **4. LE METEQUE -** Surprising 3rd of 11 in a 2100m Class C here on 21 March. Sports a new configuration but still represents no more than a minor place chance

Less-performant over the winter, KANA DE BEYLEV (15) faces her first objective of the spring and will be barefoot for the occasion. KEMIA DU CHENE (9) was not the luckiest here late last month and will be expected to turn the tables on KONFINEE (8) who just had her measure that day. Barefoot following a pair of conditioners, KYRIELLE (13) will be reined by Eric Raffin for the first time and is sure to generate interest.

- **3. KAPITANO DE SOURCE -** Last of 8 behind KOBAYASHI (4), at 139/1, in a 2450m Caen Class B a month ago and can be confidently disregarded
- **4. KOBAYASHI -** Sanctioned when going well in Prix Ovide Moulinet before running 5th of 8 in a 2450m Caen Class B on 10 March. Shod to preference this time and while not a priority, can still make first 5
- **5. KATAKI DE WALLIS -** 6th of 15 on re-entry in a 2450m Caen Class D early last month. Won his only Gr.2 start, races unshod, and is not incapable of upsetting the apple-cart

- **7. KANTO AVIS -** Hard to knock at present, most recently flying up in a Gr.3 over track and trip on 23 February. Seems to have found a higher gear recently and must be taken seriously
- **8. KRISTAL JOSSELYN -** 9th of 14 in a 2200m Caen Class D a month ago. Of the boil since last summer and can be passed over

Summary: By some margin the richest horse here, and for good reason, KOCTEL DU DAIN (10) simply excels over 2700m and even though unseen since January, he races barefoot for the occasion and should logically take all of the beating. David Thomain will still be wary of the rejuvenated and reconfigured KSAR (9) whose Prix de Selection performance bodes well for his chances, and KANTO AVIS (7) who confirmed his superb Prix Ovide Moulinet effort (behind Kokote) when victorious in the Gr.3 Prix de la Mayenne. KATAKI DE WALLIS (5) put in a decent return run at Caen and, barefoot for the first time, looks competitive for a spot in the mix.

- **6. MESSI PASS -** Imposed over inner track before running 2nd of 5 finishers to METEORE DE SIMM (8) in 2700m Gr.2 Prix Félicien Gauvreau here 3 weeks ago, and is in with a shout of repeating
- **7. MHUM FLYNG -** Progressive colt that ran 3rd of 5 finishers to METEORE DE SIMM (8) in 2700m Gr.2 Prix Félicien Gauvreau here 3 weeks ago. Unlikely to win this time but nevertheless represents a leading opponent
- **8. METEORE DE SIMM -** Routed the opposition in 2700m Gr.2 Prix Félicien Gauvreau here on 21 March. Is undefeated in this branch of the game and looks set to remain that way

Summary: With 3 priority berths to June's Gr.1 Prix d'Essai on the line here, one of them could almost be handed straight to METEORE DE SIMM (8) given his meteoric rise since embarking on a monte career. Leading the opposition, MHUM FLYNG (7) was just headed by MESSI PASS (6) that day and Victor Saussaye will be expecting to turn the tables. The well-related MATIGNON (4) debuts in the discipline, with Alexandre Abrivard in the irons, and should give a competitive account.
