C1 - PRIX DE SAINT-MANDE - 2100m (a1m1/4) - Class F Amateur Drivers Race - Harness - EUR € 12,000

- **1. JACKPOT D'ORGUEIL -** By no means disgraced when 5th of 8 in a 2875m Enghien Class E on 19 July. Takes a big dip in category, has never failed to deliver under these conditions, and must be taken seriously
- **2. IOKINA DE KERYANN -** Last of 15 in a 2850m Brehal amateurs Class H on 11 August. Has won 3 of last 6 though, including over longer here, and will legitimately generate interest
- **3. JACKPOT DE JUMILLY -** 3rd of 6 finishers in a 2950m Saint-Malo Class E 2.5 weeks ago. Has been entrusted to Emilie Duperche and looks thoroughly capable of winning a race of this nature
- **4. JET DE BUSSET -** Put in a good finish to come 3rd of 10 in a 2725m Cabourg Class E 2.5 weeks ago. Enjoys a fine spot on front line and with hind shoes off could well impose
- **5. ITHENA DE GAJUEL -** Returns to Paris for first time in almost 4 years after running 5th of 10 in a 2625m Saint-Jean-de-Monts Class F early this month, but still not an obvious choice
- **6. HEGA DES LANDIERS -** 3rd of 11 in a 2475m Francheville monte Class H last Sunday but in this field has no possible chance
- **7. IDEAL FOUR -** Returns to the amateur division after coming 4th of 8 finishers in a 2550m Bacqueville-en-Caux Class H and will need to find considerably more
- **8. HORACE DU VIVIER -** Somewhat spirited lately but ran reassuring 2nd of 10 in a 2150m Enghien amateurs Class F 9 days ago. Forced to break wide but in this small field looks a decent place chance
- **9. IMAKO VERDERIE** Makes amateur bow after running 5th of 14 in a 3125m Granville Class E on 3 August. Starts wide on front line and would be preferred barefoot
- **10. JACQUOT DU DOME -** Made it 3 straight eliminations when faulting in a 2750m Cabourg Class E 8 days ago. Won his last amateur event though and, shod to preference, can defy the draw and get in on the action
- **11. JUMEIGE DE GODREL** Made it 5 straight eliminations after faulting in a 3100m Chinon Class F midmonth and can be confidently disregarded
- **12. HESTIA DES PLAINES -** Finds herself in better company after winning a 2700m Gramat amateurs Class H 3 weeks ago but appears to have her work cut out this time
- **13. ISBA DU DOME** Back on a hard surface after being eliminated in a 2550m Bacqueville-en-Caux Class H mid-month. Handed an unfavourable draw but has solid amateur credentials and should not be ruled out

Summary: Solid in both starts since his spring break and confirmed under these conditions, JACKPOT DE JUMILLY (3) enjoys a terrific spot behind the car, sports 4 pads for the first time, and has every chance of making his amateur debut a victorious one. JET DE BUSSET (4) though appears to be close to his best, also sports modified shoeing, and looks the main danger. Faithful for the most part and proven in the amateur division, JACKPOT D'ORGUEIL (1) will be no pushover. HORACE DU VIVIER (8) tends to prefer the inner track but he thrives at this level and despite the draw still looks competitively well in.

- **1. KRAC BOREAL** Quickly sanctioned, on return to competition, in a 2850m Mauquenchy Class F 2.5 weeks ago. Has merit but is going to need another run
- **2. KIMONO DU CAIEU -** Unremarkable 6th of 11 in a 2775m Class F at Les Sables-d'Olonne 2.5 weeks ago and is not about to create an upset
- **3. KIWI DU BISSON -** Pleasantly surprising 2nd of 5 finishers in a 2625m Cherbourg Class E on 17 July, but a repeat seems improbable
- **4. KENTUCKY SCARLET -** Back under harness, and more competitively shod, after being eliminated in a 2750m Cabourg monte Class F mid-August, but others still easier to trust
- **5. KEEP TRUST** It took 18 months but returned to the winners' circle after lifting a 2725m Class F at Miramont-de-Guyenne mid-month, but at this level will have little to offer
- **6. KARCIMONT -** Put a pair of eliminations behind him to run 3rd of 5 in a 2925m Cagnes Class D 9 days ago. Takes on a less-exalted bunch this time and with form maintained can wrap this up
- **7. KEL DIABLO ERGEE** Steps up in category after dominating a 3100m Chinon Class F 8 days ago. Is new to Vincennes but is plainly in form and can play a part if he takes to the new conditions
- **8. KENAVO PAROYO -** 7th of 11 finishers in a 2725m Pornichet Class F 9 days ago. Has bags of ability but appears to have lost his way and must first reassure

Summary: KARCIMONT (6) held his own in good company at Cagnes-sur-Mer recently, placed on his only start under these conditions, and can win this if applied. He will still encounter resistance from KOKO DU CANTER (9) who just last month caught the eye in his new configuration, and KELAS (10) who had his measure that day before faulting at Cabourg next time. Sporting front pads for the first time since January, KAVANI (14) benefits from a wonderful entry and Killian Achard will be eager to take advantage.

- **2. LAST MAN -** Comfortably imposed at Enghien before failing to deliver when 8th behind LOVE GLYCINES (4) in race of reference. Clearly has merit but is not a priority this time around
- **3. LUTIN DE REUX -** Finished valiant 7th of 14 behind LOVE GLYCINES (4) in a 2875m Enghien Class B late last month despite having been unsure of stride. On better behaviour can contest the finish
- **4. LOVE GLYCINES -** Hard to knock since the spring, latterly 3rd of 14 in a 2875m Enghien Class B late last month. Left a good impression that day and will justifiably garner support
- **5. LYRIKO BELLO -** Disappointing on the whole over recent months, latterly eliminated in a 2875m Enghien Class B late last month, and can expect to have few friends
- **6. LORD DELO** Has not been seen out since dominating a 2850m Gr.3 here last January. Quite clearly means business and JMB will be expecting immediate confirmation. Claim

Summary: Armed with a third of this small field, the Bazire stable looks particularly dangerous, notably with LORD DELO (6) who is plainly primed for action. - **2. LOLITA -** Won 3 on the trot before coming 3rd of 10 in a Class D under these conditions last February. Unseen since but has plainly been primed for action and can get straight down to business
- **3. LUCIA DE BUSSET -** Did not enjoy the best of trips in a 2150m Enghien Class D a month ago, coming last of 11 behind LAURENE DE BAILLY (4). Is significantly better than that though and the JMB-factor cannot be ignored
- **4. LAURENE DE BAILLY -** 9th of 12 behind LADY PRINCESS (6) in a 2875m Enghien Class D 9 days ago. Alexandre Abrivard in the bike this time but will have other priorities
- **5. LIANGA** Returned to winning ways at Clairefontaine before running 6th of 11 behind LAURENE DE BAILLY (4) in a 2150m Enghien Class D a month ago. Has been entrusted to Eric Raffin for the first time and must not be underestimated
- **6. LADY PRINCESS -** Unthreatening 6th of 12 in a 2875m Enghien Class D 9 days ago and would be preferred at a lower level
- **7. LYRIDE ORLOVE -** Progressive filly that ran 6th of 10, on return to competition, in a 2150m Argentan Class D 2 weeks ago. Will have come on for the run and with Anthony Barrier in the bike, will be afforded a competitive drive. Place chance
- **8. LA MISS ROYALE -** Made amends for Enghien sanction when making short work of a 2850m Mauquenchy Class E on 24 July. Is new to 2100m here but can play a prominent role if Philippe Daugeard keeps her focused
- **9. LATINA TOURNIBOIS -** Got off the mark for 2025 in a 2400m Amiens Class E late last month. Is clearly in shape but has pulled a tough number and in this company will have her work cut out
- **10. LA PERLA DE LOU -** Got back in the game 2 weeks ago when 2nd of 11 in a 2150m Enghien Class E. Is new to Vincennes and while not a priority is still worth keeping an eye on

Summary: Quite the revelation last winter, LOLITA (2) may not have been seen out since February but she is shod to preference for her comeback and is reunited with Benjamin Rochard who has already won with her. LA KIFFANCE PIYA (11) is forced to start from the rear but she makes her Vincennes debut on a 4-timer and, barefoot for the first time, could just oblige. LYRIDE ORLOVE (7) is not the most dependable but she has a race under her belt and is confirmed at the venue. Eye-catching winner at Mauquenchy a month back, LA MISS ROYALE (8) has been reconfigured for her return to Paris and must be afforded respect.

- **2. JUST FOR BACK -** 3rd of 12 in a 2875m Enghien Gr.2, in 1'12"5, a fortnight back. Takes a notable dip in class and looks main rival to JE M'ENVOLE (3)
- **3. JE M'ENVOLE -** Would have finished close in a 2875m Enghien harness Class B late last month had he stayed in stride. Returns to code of preference in excellent shape and will be difficult to oppose
- **4. HELIOT DE CAHOT** Encouraged at Hyeres but failed to confirm when 10th of 13 in a 3100m Nort-sur-Erdre harness Class A on 10 August. Has no monte references but with Anthony Barrier aboard, and reconfigured for the occasion, can get a look in
- **5. SELF EXPLOSIVE -** 12th of 14 over 2400m in Ostend a month ago. Unseen under the saddle since late-2023 and even though barefoot with Alexandre Abrivard in the irons is still not an obvious choice
- **6. GOOD GIRL MARCEAUX -** Capable on a good day but will need to show marked improvement on her last of 10 in a 2875m Enghien Gr.3 on 10 July
- **7. HALFA** 4th of 12 in a 2300m Mons harness conditioner 2.5 weeks ago. Boasts solid credentials over 2850m on the main track and the engagement of Eric Raffin speaks for itself
- **8. IN LOVE DU CHOQUEL -** Serious sort starting for first time since running 3rd of 8 in a Gr.2 over course and distance late last November. Excellent even with shoes on and can figure prominently if sufficiently tuned up

Summary: After 4 return runs under harness, JE M'ENVOLE (3) is barefoot for his first objective of the season and with application will take all the beating. Principal opposition should likely come from JUST FOR BACK (2) whose recent Enghien performance did not go unnoticed, and the returning IN LOVE DU CHOQUEL (8) who boasts excellent references even when shod. Reunited with Eric Raffin after a pleasant Mons conditioner, and barefoot for the occasion, HALFA (7) is not easy to ignore.

- **1. MAZAR DE VANDEL -** Got off the mark at Le Mont-Saint-Michel before running 3rd of 7 in a 2950m Saint-Malo Class D 2.5 weeks ago, but is quite simply out of his depth
- **2. MOONWALK D'HERIPRE -** Sent for a rest after imposing at Nantes in May and most recently confirmed on re-entry, winning a 2500m Class D at La Rochelle earlier this month. Is unbeaten with Eric Raffin who will be trying to keep that fact relevant
- **3. MUCHO CASH -** Won a 2925m Cagnes Class D for new trainer 12 days ago. Jean-Michel Bazire reins this time but at this level may find the going somewhat tougher
- **4. MIX D'ERONVILLE -** Placed over course and distance before running 5th of 10 behind MISTRAL CASTELLE (9) in a 2700m Graignes Class B 2 weeks ago, but will need to find significantly more
- **5. MARIANNA** Pleasant 2nd of 11 in a 2875m Enghien Class C on 27 July but takes on too much this time around
- **6. MALVINA MADRIK** Reassuring 3rd of 4 finishers in a 2875m Enghien Class C 3 weeks ago. Put in a good finish that day and will have her trainer in the bike this time. Place prospect

- **9. MISTRAL CASTELLE -** Has not put a foot wrong lately, latterly 3rd of 10 in a 2700m Graignes Class B 2 weeks ago. Faces a much stiffer test this time but should nevertheless hold his own
- **10. MAGIC NIGHT** Made up for Enghien elimination when beating Mille Etoiles in a 2175m Gr.2 here last weekend and is the only horse that can legitimately oppose MACK DE BLARY (11)
- **11. MACK DE BLARY -** Facile winner of a 2875m Enghien Gr.3 on 2 August, his first start since February. Will appreciate a return to Vincennes and is in with a serious shout of repeating

Summary: A classy individual that dominated an Enghien Gr.3 on his recent return to competition, MACK DE BLARY (11) looks set to prove why his is the richest horse in the field. That being said, the complicated MAGIC NIGHT (10) just won a Gr.2 in 1'11"5 here last week and, with application, will be no soft touch. MORE AND MORE (8) is still a maiden and has never been tested in this class of company, but he has talent to burn and deserves to be taken seriously. Barring last month's elimination, MALVINA MADRIK (6) has been a model of consistency and should find a more suitable pace this time.

- **2. MEPHISTO DU CLOS** Returns to his code of preference after finishing last of 11 in a 2725m Pornichet harness conditioner 9 days ago. Has never been tested at this level but has a lot of untapped potential and looks an interesting candidate
- **3. MANOU DU CHENE** Last of 10 on comeback in a 2875m Enghien harness Class B a fortnight ago. Won a brace under the saddle before the break but appears to have a lot more to find
- **4. MENTALIST AR -** Has not been seen out since being eliminated in a Class A over course and distance on 10 June and already looks out of his league
- **5. MONTANA WOOD** Eliminated in Prix d'Essai, then again in a 2875m Enghien harness Class B 2 weeks ago, and is unlikely to generate much interest
- **6. MAGNOLIADARCHE -** Put away after opening his account in a Class A under these conditions on 10 June. 9th of 10 on re-entry in a 2700m Graignes harness Class B 2 weeks ago but in this company is unlikely to spring any surprises
- **7. MALICE CAILLERIE** Won a Gr.3 over 2700m here before being eliminated early in Prix d'Essai. Has bags of talent though and will be no pushover if Anthony Barrier keeps her focused

- **10. MELODY DE VIVOIN** Surprise 2nd in Gr.1 Prix d'Essai before finishing last of 4 in a 2875m Enghien harness Gr.3 conditioner 3 weeks ago. Unlikely to get her nose in front but can still play a prominent part
- 11. MHUM FLYNG Eliminated after losing his action in 2700m Gr.1 Prix d'Essai on 22 June after having routed the opposition in the Gr.2 Prix Pierre Gamare at Caen. Comes here fresh and with application can return to winning ways

Summary: Gr.2 winner at Caen in may, MHUM FLYNG (11) was unsure of stride in the Prix d'Essai but has talent in spades, freshness on his side, and Victor Saussaye will be determined to set the record straight. MATIGNON (8) though ran 2nd in a Gr.2 under these conditions earlier in the spring before leaving an excellent impression in the Gr.1 Prix d'Essai in June. Second that day at 102/1, MELODY DE VIVOIN (10) will garner a lot more support this time and should again figure prominently, but she may first have to defer to MISTY GREEN (12) who is significantly better than her 6th place would suggest.

- **2. KARAMBAR** 4th to KILLIAM FROMENTRO (5) in a Gr.3 here before being eliminated in a 2875m Enghien Gr.3 early last month. Is in conditioning-mode this time though and not a priority
- **3. EDGAR SABA -** Got back in the game on 5 July when 2nd of 11 in a 2875m Enghien Gr.3. Has placed just twice in 5 starts over course and distance though and cannot be regarded more than a minor place chance
- **4. JAZZMAN (GER) -** Ran a good 5th of 16 in a 3100m Vibraye Class D mid-month. Shod to preference this time, has previously beaten KILLIAM FROMENTRO (5), and is not incapable of doing so again

JMB will still want to be wary of the terrifically entered DIAMOND TRUPPO (12) who stormed up on his first start for the Duvaldestin stable, and JAZZMAN (GER) (4) who is shod as he was when winning a similar event here in May. The change of scenery has done a world of good for JUST A MIDI (6) who returns to Vincennes with a good hand to play.
