C1 - PRIX DE GIMONT - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class D - Mounted - EUR € 59,000

1. NYMKE BRIGADOON - A faller last time out in a Class D mounted race at La Capelle over 2750m on 3 September. Needs to do a lot more to win this race

2. INKY PERRINE - Battling to find best form and finished 5th in a Class E harness race over 2650m on 5 September. Needs to do more to beat these rivals

3. STACCATO HL - In good form and was third in a Class D mounted race at La Capelle over 2750m on 3 September. Can make the frame

4. HERAKLION DESBOIS - On a long losing run and was 7th in a Class E harness race at Reims over 2500m on 14 September. More is needed to beat these rivals

5. IMPERIAL KEY - A winner of his last two starts, the latest in a Class E mounted race at Feurs over 2225m on 8 September. Can complete his hat-trick

6. IKYTA DE LA VALLEE - Disqualified last time out at Rambouillet over 2800m on 7 September. Very unreliable but is capable of playing a minor role

7. IGOR DU PARC - Disqualified last time out at La Capelle over 2750m on 3 September. In very good form before that and can return to his winning ways

8. IMELDA - Much improved in her last run when third in a Class E mounted race at Granville over 3125m on 3 August. Consistent under the saddle and can be a lively danger

9. IROKO DU LOIR - Has improved of late and was runner-up in a Class D mounted race at Pornichet-La Baule over 2725m on 11 July. Be right there at the finish

10. DONIZETTI (SWE) - Has really struggled of late and was 12th in Class D at Vincennes over 2100m on 12 September. Needs major improvement to win

Summary: A competitive opening event. IGOR DU PARC (7) faulted at La Capelle earlier this month but was in very good form before that and can bounce back to beat these rivals if staying in stride. IMELDA (8) is very consistent in this discipline and would not be a surprise winner. IMPERIAL KEY (5) is in very good form and should be a threat yet again. IROKO DU LOIR (9) is usually competitive and is clearly not out of it.

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C2 - PRIX BIANCA - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class D - Harness - EUR € 40,000

- 1. MAGIC CASH** - Continues to improve and was victorious in Class E at Meslay-du-Maine over 2875m on 15 August. Can double up
- 2. MAMBO THORIS** - Disqualified in his last two starts, the latest being at La Capelle over 2750m on 3 September. Capable of earning some money when staying on the trot
- 3. MONDIAL DE FAVEROL** - Has some fair form and finished fourth in Class B at La Capelle over 2750m on 3 September. More is needed to beat these rivals
- 4. MOZART DU DOLLAR** - Has some fair form and finished third in Class D at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 11 August. Might play a minor role
- 5. MINUS DE CHENU** - Unreliable but was runner-up in Class E at this track over 2100m on 2 September. Better that shorter distance but cannot be ruled out
- 6. MILLIUM QUESNOT** - In good shape and finished third in Class D at Enghien over 2150m on 13 August. Has a place chance in this line-up
- 7. MAESTRO BILOU** - Only modest of late and finished 7th in Class D at Meslay-du-Maine over 2875m on 10 September. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- 8. MY DREAM MESLOIS** - Disqualified in his last two starts, the latest being at Cabourg over 2750m on 26 August. Has ability and is capable of winning when smart
- 9. MILLE MERCIS** - Not disgraced when 5th in Class D at Meslay-du-Maine over 2875m on 10 September. Has won twice this year and must be respected for that. Has claims
- 10. MILORD DE BUY** - In good shape and finished third in Class D at this track over 2850m on 16 June. Returns from a break and could need this run
- 11. MILLESIME GRIFF** - Only modest so far and finished 6th in Class C at Enghien over 2875m on 10 August. Capable of an upset on best form
- 12. MARQUIS DU CHENE** - Has disqualification issues and faulted last time out at Feurs over 2100m on 8 September. Capable of contesting the finish when smart
- 13. MEGINO** - Returned to form with a Class E win at Vichy over 2150m on 2 August. Can follow up if in the same mood
- 14. MALKO MESLOIS** - Disqualified last time out at Cabourg over 2750m on 26 August. Not easy to trust but can bounce back to score if staying on the trot

Summary: MALKO MESLOIS (14) is not easy to trust and is coming off a disqualification at Cabourg, but he can score when smart. The same can be said of his rival MY DREAM MESLOIS (8), who has two recent disqualifications. He had very good form before that and is a real threat. MEGINO (13) tackles tougher company this time but is improving and clearly not out of it. MILLE MERCIS (9) is not reliable but is another quite capable of shining.

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**C3 - PRIX D'ISSIGEAC - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class C - Mounted - EUR €
53,000**

1. KEPI ROUGE - Only modest of late and finished 6th in a Class E mounted race at Laval over 2850m on 15 September. Could play a minor role at best

2. KING DE PLAY - Unreliable but was victorious last time out in a Class E mounted race at Laval over 2850m on 15 September. Can follow up

3. EMPIRE AS - Kept to harness races so far and was victorious in a Class D harness race at this track over 2100m on 30 August. Can be a threat trying a mounted race

4. KILOU D'YMER - Did not show his best when 11th in a Class D harness race at Châteaubriant over 3000m on 14 September. Does better under the saddle and can contest the finish

5. KOBALT DU VALLON - Disqualified last time out at Cabourg over 2750m on 29 August. On a very long losing run but could earn some minor money

6. KARNA DES BAULTS - Has disqualification issues but did run well when barefoot and fourth in a Class C mounted race over this course and distance on 15 April. Returns from a break but races without shoes and is not out of it

7. KENTUCKY FIRST - Disqualified last time out at Compiègne over 2800m on 7 September. Likes this track and can bounce back to score

8. KLINGER (NOR) - Disqualified last time out at Les Sables-d'Olonne over 2775m on 25 July. Capable of popping up in a place when in the right mood

Summary: KENTUCKY FIRST (7) fluffed his lines in his comeback start with a disqualification. He has a good record at this track and looks the one to be with back under the saddle. KARNA DES BAULTS (6) is not easy to trust but returns from a break racing without shoes and can be a real threat. KILOU D'YMER (4) is consistent in mounted races, is barefoot, and looks ready to strike. EMPIRE AS (3) was a good winner last time out and must be respected for that, but he is trying this discipline for the first time.

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C4 - PRIX EMILE BEZIERE - 2850m (a2m) - Gr3 - Harness - EUR € 90,000

- 1. EDGAR SABA** - In good shape and finished third in a Group 3 at this track over 2700m on 23 August. Can contest the finish once again
- 2. JAZZMAN (GER)** - In good form and was runner-up in a Group 3 at this track over 2700m on 23 August. Be right there at the finish
- 3. ENCIERRO (ITY)** - Has been kept to short distances of late and finished 6th at Taranto over 1600m on 27 July. Capable of making the frame
- 4. KILLIAM FROMENTRO** - Clearly capable of better when 5th in a Group 3 at this track over 2700m on 23 August. Big chance this course and distance
- 5. ELEGANCE KRONOS** - Has held form nicely of late and was runner-up in Class C at Les Sables-d'Olonne over 2000m on 29 August. Can make the frame
- 6. JASPER DES CHARMES** - Has major disqualification issues and faulted last time out at this track over 3000m on 14 September. Could be the surprise package of the race
- 7. JEWELCANDLE FAC** - Showed what she is capable of when third in a Group 1 mounted race at this track over 2700m on 19 January. Likely to need this run returning from a break
- 8. IZNOGOUD AM** - Unreliable and finished 8th in Class B over this course and distance on 13 September. Can play a minor role at very best
- 9. JEEGHA PRIDE** - Battling to regain best form and was 9th in a Group 3 at this track over 2700m on 23 August. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
- 10. JINGLE DU PONT** - Victorious last time out in Class B at Enghien over 2875m on 30 July. Not barefoot this time and others make more appeal
- 11. EDY GIRIFALCO GIO** - Kept to much shorter distances and was 6th at Montecatini over 1640m on 15 August. Can play a minor role this distance
- 12. JANGO VICI** - Has only been modest of late and finished 7th in a Group 2 at La Capelle over 1800m on 3 September. Could be a threat this longer distance
- 13. JAG STRYCK** - Has struggled in both starts this year and was 12th in Class D at Laval over 2850m on 24 August. Capable of improvement but others are preferred
- 14. JAZZ IN MONTREUX** - Disqualified last time out at Alencon over 2625m on 7 September. Better under the saddle and others make more appeal

Summary: KILLIAM FROMENTRO (4) did not show his best when only fifth behind rivals JAZZMAN (GER) (2) and EDGAR SABA (1). He is better over this distance and can bounce back to win. JAZZMAN (GER) (2) remains in very good shape and should fight out the finish once again. EDGAR SABA (1) is also in good form and has claims. ENCIERRO (ITY) (3) makes the trip from Italy and could appreciate this longer distance.

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C5 - PRIX MYRRHA - 2100m (a1m1/4) - Class R Claiming - Harness - EUR € 18,000

1. **LUSSABEAU** - Only modest of late and finished 9th in Class D at this track over 2700m on 25 August. Has yet to win a race and others are preferred
2. **LANNISTER D'AVRIL** - Has some fair form of late and was 5th in Class D at Vichy over 2950m on 26 August. On a long losing run but can get involved with the finish
3. **LIBRE PENSEUR MEEK** - Has major disqualification issues and faulted last time out at Graignes over 2700m on 30 August. Capable of a surprise when staying on the trot
4. **LOZEN DE BANVILLE** - Did not show her best when 8th in this division at this track over 2850m on 27 August. Capable of doing better this distance and can earn some money
5. **LA GUARDIA** - Disqualified twice in her last three starts, including last time out at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 17 September. Could be a threat in this division if smart
6. **LAYLA** - Disqualified last time out at Vichy over 2150m on 2 June. Needs major improvement to win this race and others make more appeal
7. **LUNIK DU CHOQUEL** - Has struggled with disqualifications of late and faulted last time out at this track over 2850m on 27 August. Probably best watched for now
8. **LOTUS DE BEYLEV** - Only modest of late and finished 8th in Class D over this track and trip on 9 September. Capable of contesting the finish
9. **LARIFLETTE** - Very consistent of late and was runner-up in a claimer at this track over 2850m on 27 August. Just as good this distance and can go one better
10. **LATINO PURA VIDA** - Has struggled all year and was 12th in Class E at Meslay-du-Maine over 2875m on 10 September. Needs to do more to win this race
11. **LANCELOT PLATANES** - Has struggled of late and was 7th in a Class E mounted race at this track over 2200m on 1 September. Capable of better and has a place chance in this line-up
12. **LYPSTIC ATOUT** - Very unreliable but was not disgraced when fourth in Class E at Pornichet-La Baule over 2725m on 28 August. Hard to trust but could play a minor role
13. **LILOU** - Struggling to find best form and was 9th in Class E at Lisieux over 2725m on 13 September. Needs to do more to win this race

Summary: LARIFLETTE (9) has held her form very nicely of late. She has no problems with this track and trip and should make a bold bid for victory. LOTUS DE BEYLEV (8) has only been modest of late but should be a threat in this division. LANNISTER D'AVRIL (2) is usually competitive and can get involved in the finish yet again. LA GUARDIA (5) is on a long losing run but is capable of making the frame at this level.

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C6 - PRIX HYDRUS - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class D - Harness - EUR € 40,000

1. **MANDRAGORA FLEURY** - Disqualified last time out at this track over 2175m on 12 September. Yet to win a race but could play a minor role
2. **MUNIA** - Disqualified last time out at this track over 2175m on 12 September. Has won over this distance and is not out of it
3. **MANDARINA DE LOU** - Only found one better on the day in Class E at this track over 2100m on 5 September. Has disqualification issues but can go one better
4. **MIRELLA DE LOU** - Unreliable of late and was not disgraced when 5th in Class D at Cabourg over 2750m on 29 August. Has won twice this year and is capable of an upset
5. **MARISA DU CHATELET** - In good form and was fourth in Class D at this track over 2175m on 12 September. Can contest the finish
6. **MUSICA JULMA** - Did not show her best when 11th in Class C at Enghien over 2875m on 27 July. In good form before that and can be a lively danger
7. **MULANE DU BOCAGE** - Improving and was victorious in Class E at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2850m on 6 August. Can follow up in this line-up
8. **MARA DIBAH** - In good shape and finished third in Class D at Meslay-du-Maine over 2875m on 10 September. Can make the finish
9. **MADONE DES RACQUES** - Has only been modest of late and was 6th in D at Cabourg over 2750m on 29 August. Better over shorter and others are preferred
10. **MADONE PIYA** - Unreliable and finished 6th in Class C at Enghien over 2875m on 27 July. Has already won twice this year and can win again
11. **MADONE DU TRIEUX** - Hard to trust and finished 9th in Class D at Les Andelys over 2525m on 14 September. Needs to find a few lengths to win

Summary: MANDARINA DE LOU (3) is not easy to trust, but she does have ability and can go one better after a very good recent performance. MADONE PIYA (10) has a hot-or-miss record and can score if she is in the right mood. MULANE DU BOCAGE (7) is improving and should fight out the finish yet again. MUNIA (2) fluffed her lines with a disqualification at this track last time out but is better over this distance and is not out of it.

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C7 - PRIX HAMALE - 2850m (a2m) - Class R Claiming Amateur Riders - Harness - EUR € 18,000

1. **HYPSO DES CAILLONS** - Hard to trust and was disqualified last time out at Moulins-la-Marche over 2800m on 14 September. Hard to trust and others make more appeal
2. **BLUE EYES BAR** - Has really struggled of late and was unplaced in Class F at Bagnoles-de-l'Orne over 2850m on 31 August. Needs to find a few lengths to win
3. **FARCEUR DE L'INAM** - In good shape and finished fourth at Hyeres over 2850m on 8 September. Should be competitive once again
4. **GOSSIP BOY** - Has struggled of last and was 8th in Class E at La Capelle over 1800m on 3 September. Needs to find a few lengths to win
5. **GREAT D'ARRY** - Disqualified last time out at Compiegne over 2800m on 7 September. Quite capable of contesting the finish when smart
6. **GENERAL D'AMOUR** - Battling to regain fom and finished 9th in Class F at Nort-sur-Erdre over 3100m on 7 September. Needs to do more to win this race
7. **HENRY DE TROUVILLE** - Disqualified last time out at this track over 2700m on 6 September. Should be a threat if staying on the trot
8. **GENTLEMAN LOVER** - Disqualified last time out at Caen over 2450m on 17 September. Battling to regain form and others are preferred
9. **GAVROCHE DU GADE** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in Class A at Auch over 2800m on 25 August. Be right there at the finish dropped to a claimer
10. **FAIRPLAY FOREVER** - Disqualified last time out at Laval over 2650m on 5 September. Capable of better and could earn some minor money
11. **ANOTHER CREATION** - Has really struggled of late and finished 12th in Class D at this track over 2100m on 30 August. Could be the surprise package of the race
12. **HERMES PAT** - Unreliable but did run well when barefoot and fourth in Class E at Agon-Coutainville over 3450m on 11 August. Can do even better at this level
13. **FOKKER DE BAILLY** - Has struggled all year and was 7th in Class D at Amiens over 2400m on 6 September. Capable of an upset in this division
14. **FILLMORE** - Has struggled of late and was 13th in a claimer at Enghien over 2150m on 9 August. Needs to find a few lengths to win

Summary: A very open-looking race where anything can happen. HERMES PAT (12) was not disgraced at Agon-Coutainville last month and should set the standard here. HENRY DE TROUVILLE (7) fluffed his lines with a disqualification at this track earlier this month but was in good form before that and has claims. GREAT D'ARRY (5) is not entirely reliable either but can be a threat in this division.

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C8 - PRIX HEKATE - 2200m (a1m1/2) - Class A - Harness - EUR € 51,000

- 1. NEOH DAIRPET** - A two-year-old gelding by Captain Sparrow out of Egérie d'Atout who is making his debut. His Dam never won a race after 13 starts. Watch the betting
- 2. NAYANA DES EPINES** - Disqualified on debut at this track over 2175m on 27 August. Capable of improvement but others make more appeal
- 3. NEAL DE TROUVILLE** - Has not been disgraced in two starts and finished fourth in Class B at this track over 2100m on 1 September. Can make the frame
- 4. NEEL AR MOR** - Showed what he is capable of with a Class E at Lisieux over 2725m on 13 September. Tougher task this time
- 5. NEVADARA** - Showed some improvement when runner-up in Class B at this track over 2100m on 2 September. Can be competitive once again
- 6. NELSON EMGE** - Looked good when scoring on debut in Class D over this track and trip on 9 September. Be right there at the finish
- 7. NITESCO DE SIMM** - Unbeaten in two starts, the latest in Class D at Enghien over 2250m on 23 July. Can complete the hat-trick

Summary: NITESCO DE SIMM (7) has looked good so far with some solid wins and will take plenty of beating in this lucky last race. This is his first experience at this track. NELSON EMGE (6) won on debut earlier this month over this course and distance, and if there is to be a threat, it is likely to come from him. NEVADARA (5) ran well at this track last time out and is clearly improving, so he can contest the finish. NEEL AR MOR (4) showed improvement to win at Lisieux, but this does look a tougher task.
