- **6. GALON D'AMIRAL** Eliminated in last 2, most recently a 2150m Mauquenchy Class E 3 weeks ago. Has never delivered over the main track but with stride in check can play a small part
- **7. INDY DE LA FYE** In the frame in 5 of last 6, latterly close 2nd of 15 in a Class D over course and distance 3 weeks ago. Boasts a superb amateur record and looks a serious proposition
- **8. FARCEUR DE L'INAM** Looked decidedly ordinary when 7th of 12 behind GOSSIP BOY (4) in a 2850m claimer over the short course 10 days ago and can be confidently passed over
- **9. GRYFFONDOR DU POLI** Last of 7 when preparing for this in a 2750m monte Class E at La Capelle 11 days ago. Has otherwise been in cracking form and will be competitive for a place in the picture
- **10. HORACE DU VIVIER -** Put in a good showing to run 2nd of 12 in a 2850m amateurs Class F here 2.5 weeks ago. Forced to start on 2nd line but can still play an active role
- **11. HISTOIRE DU LUPIN -** Missed out on the 3-timer when 2nd of 9 in a 2600m Class E at Le Mont-Saint-Michel on 17 August. Has yet to be bested in the amateur category though and Martin Prat will be eager to keep that fact relevant
- **12. GRANADOS** Runner-up in last 2 amateur starts, most recently a Class F over course and distance on 9 September. On back row this time but can still get in on the action
- 13. HOTOT 2nd of 8 finishers in a 2825m Vire claimer 12 days ago. On back line and is not about to confirm
- **14. HIDAO DE LA GOUTTE -** Last of 9 in a 3025m Class H at Montier-en-Der on 10 August. Has freshness on his side but little else

Summary: Very unlucky not to pull off the hat-trick here in late-August, JADE DE NAVARY (1) should more than make amends if Sven Hoste keeps her out of trouble. She will still come under pressure from back-line starter HISTOIRE DU LUPIN (11) who herself came close to making it 3 on the trot last time out. Better-placed on the front row, INDY DE LA FYE (7) has been knocking at the door for months and it will not be long before he trots his way back into the winners' circle. Very much at home at Vincennes, GRYFFONDOR DU POLI (9) goes barefoot and can expect considerable support.
